Safety - Please remember, for the safety of children, dogs are not allowed in the school playground at any time, and vehicles should not use the driveway to drop-off or collect children. There is an arrangement with the Shoulder of Mutton which allows you to park for preschool arrivals and departures, however please do not block the back entrance to the pub.
