I have outlined some of the comments that were made on the questionnaire below. It is very difficult to respond to them all, however all comments have been noted, considered and acted on if possible.

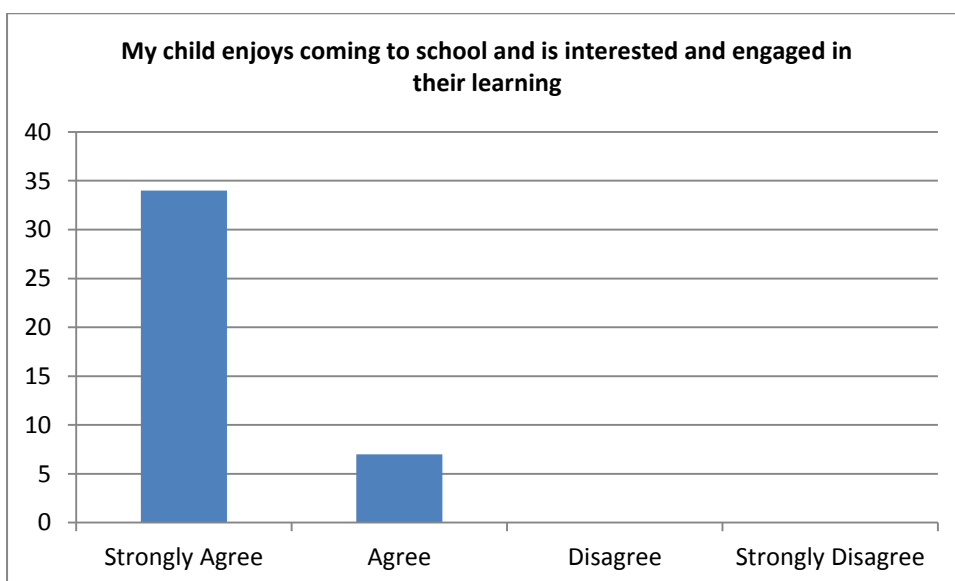
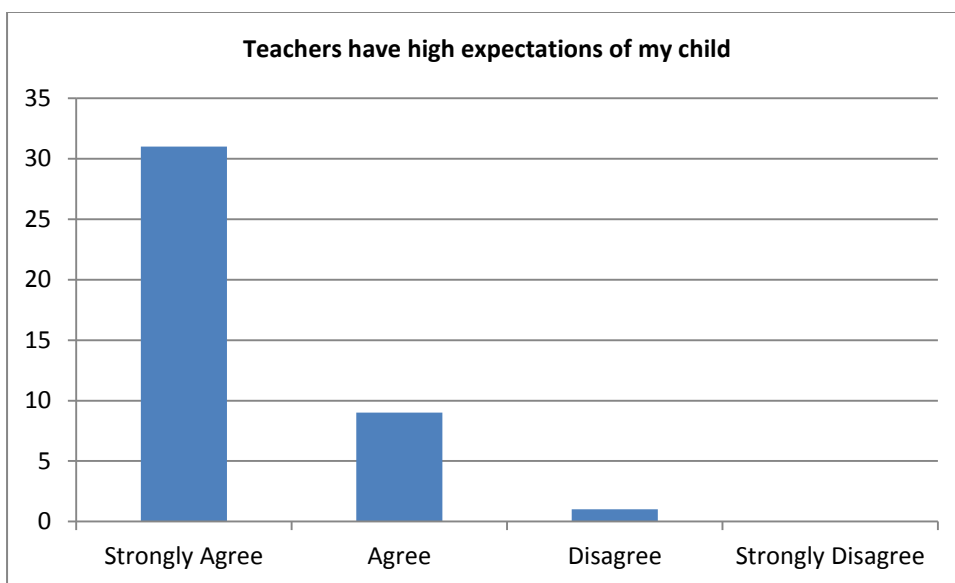
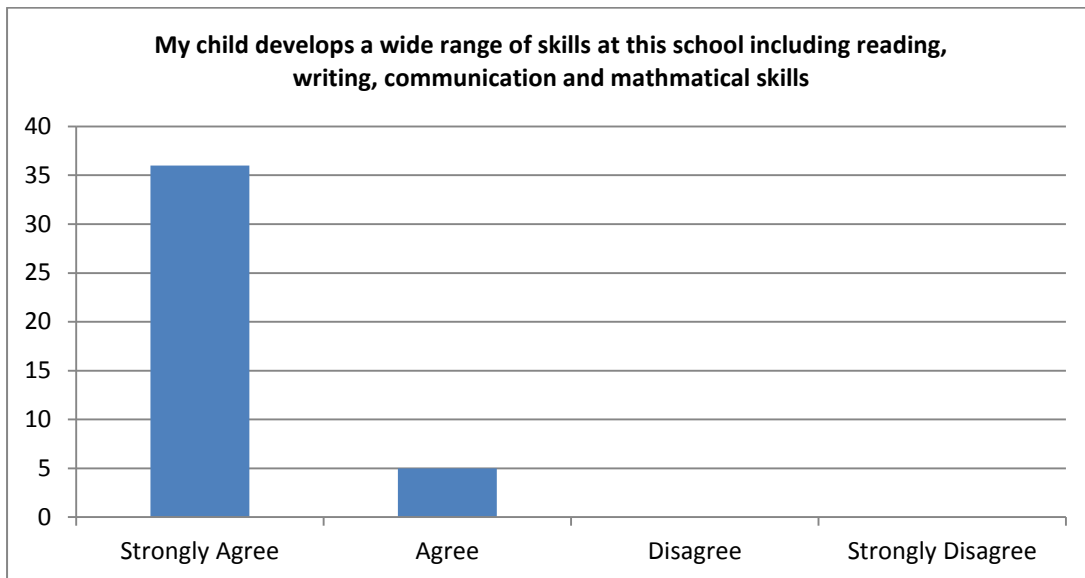
I am pleased to list below some of your comments on what you felt we do really well as a school.

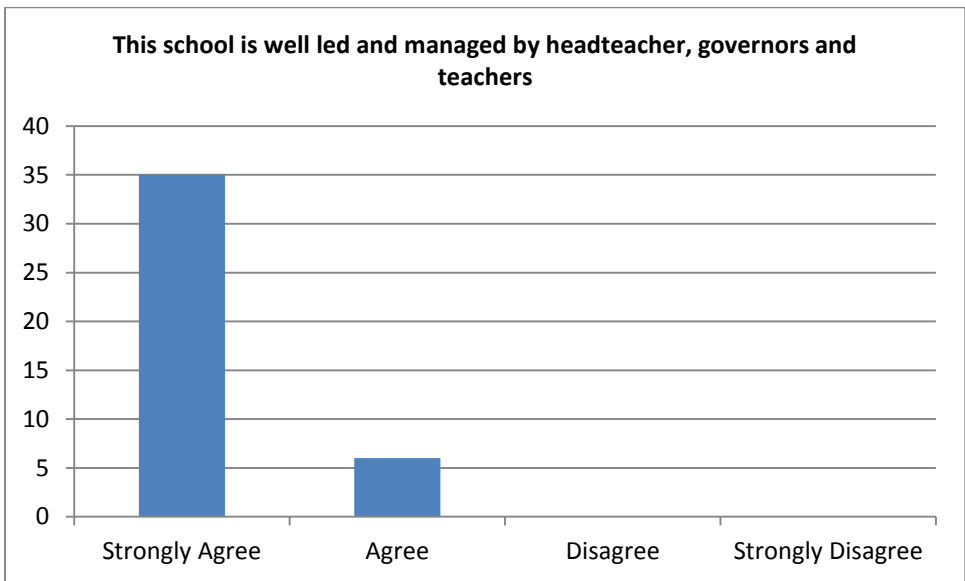
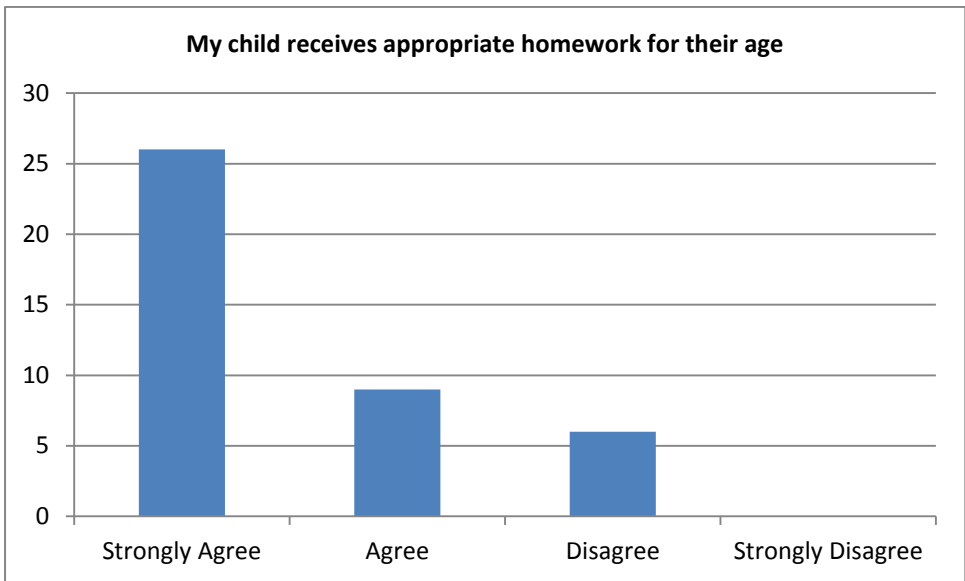
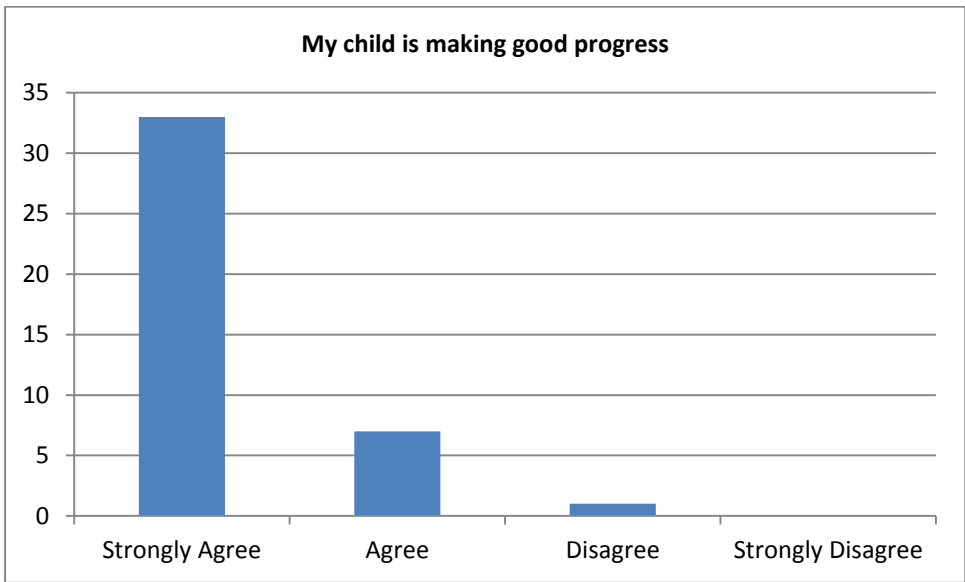
1. The school organises successful events.

12. Our school values and uses links with the local church and community.

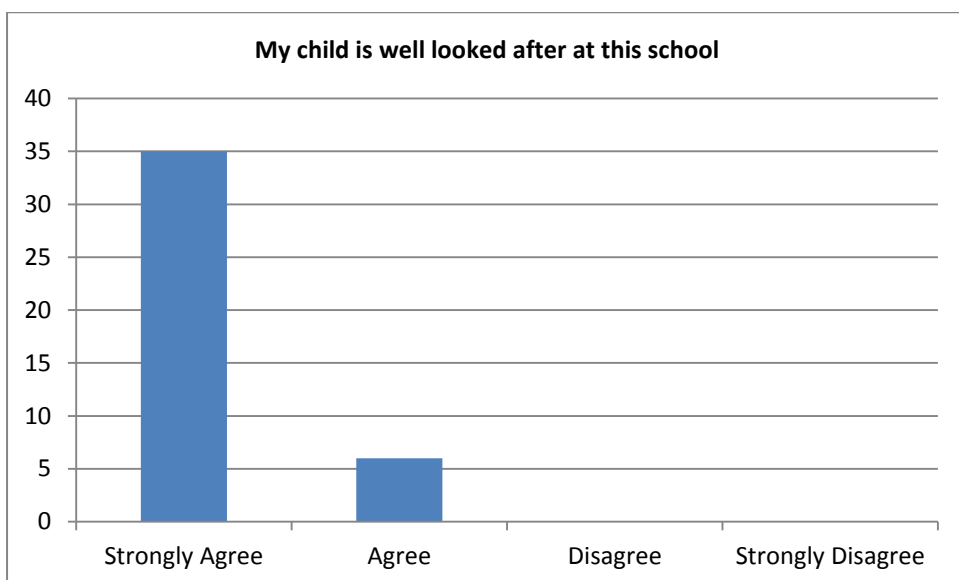
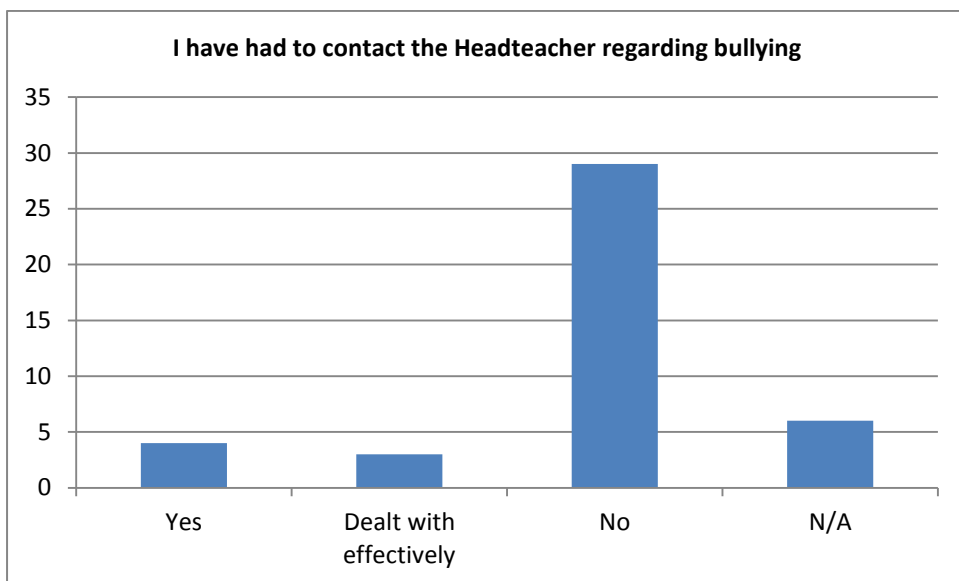
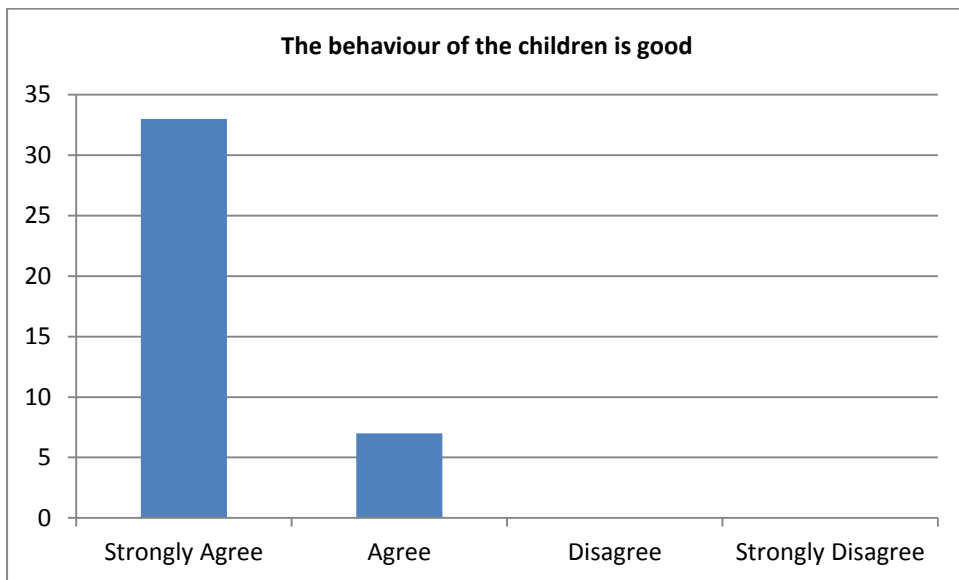
Some of the areas you feel we need to focus on:

1. Teachers have high expectations of my child.	One parent expressed that the teachers do not have high expectations of their child. Targets are shared with parents at consultation day and the school has an open door policy where parents can make an appointment to discuss the expectations the teachers have for their child/ren.
2. My child receives appropriate homework for their age.	Some parents still disagree that their child receives age appropriate homework. The school have addressed this issue by introducing project books and revision guides for our year 6 pupils. Every child has an Education City logon where children can access age appropriate homework as often as required. The school also sent out information regarding alternative homework providers.

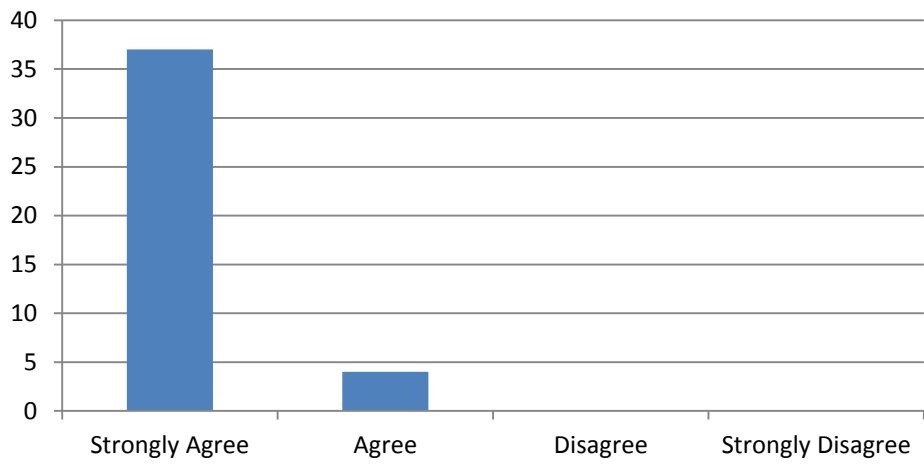
