## **Landywood School Uniform**

## All items should be clearly marked.

For uniform purposes:

Winter is from October half term holiday to Easter holiday. Summer is following Easter holidays until October half term.

**GIRLS**: Winter Grey pinafore dress, skirt or plain straight-legged trousers

White polo shirt

Royal blue cardigan or jumper

Grey tights, white or grey long socks

Suitable coat.

<u>Summer</u> Blue and white check dress in any simple style

Royal blue cardigan

Lightweight, shower-proof jacket.

**BOYS**: Winter Grey trousers

White polo shirt

Royal blue sweatshirt or V-neck jumper

Suitable coat

<u>Summer</u> Grey trousers or shorts

White polo shirt

Royal blue sweatshirt or V-neck jumper

Lightweight, shower-proof jacket.

SHOES: Winter; Black, blue or brown shoes - maximum heel height 3cm

Summer; Black - brown or navy sandals (closed toes) of a - sensible style are permitted - maximum heel height 3cm

Reception children – a pair of Wellington boots

P.E. KIT: Black shorts

Plain round neck T-shirt in house team colour

(Red, Royal blue, Yellow or Green)

Nursery children should wear a plain white t-shirt

Pumps/Trainers

All clearly marked and in a named school pump bag

BOOK BAG: All children require a blue school branded book bag.

All items (inc branded items) can be obtained from Crested Uniform, Cannock, or Tesco Cannock.

School will not be responsible for damage to items of clothing

## **EARRINGS, JEWELLERY, MAKE UP**

Small, stud-style earrings only should be worn. We would ask to try, where possible, to have new ear piercings done at the start of the six weeks summer holidays to ensure they are properly healed for term time.

No earrings can be worn during PE lessons, so it is advised to remove all earrings at home on PE days. If this is not possible, your child will need to remove them and reinsert them themselves.

Necklaces, rings or any other jewellery must not be worn. (Unless for religious or cultural reasons).

The use of nail varnish, false nails or nail extensions, make up or tattoos (permanent or non-permanent) are not allowed.

If any of these are visible in school, your child will be asked to remove them. If this is not possible at school, they will be given 24 hrs to rectify the issue. If after this time the issue remains, your child will be excluded from school.

## **HAIRSTYLES**

For safety and hygiene reasons long hair should be tied back. Plain, simple hairclips/slides, bows and bands can be worn, it is be preferred if these are blue or white in colour. No JoJo bows ( or similar) are allowed in school.

Extreme hairstyles are not permitted nor are unnatural hair colours. If any child arrives in school sporting a style, which is considered by the Head Teacher to be extreme, you will be asked to resolve the concern within 24 hrs. If after 24hrs, the issue remains your child will be excluded will be retained for future use.

Head lice are easy to treat but can keep coming back so please check your child's hair regularly for lice infestation and treat accordingly.
