

ENGLISH

Using Michael Morpurgo's book as the basis of the topic children will write balanced arguments, ship's logs, character descriptions and missing posters, simple instructions, information texts and alternative story endings. They will use inference and deduction in guided reading sessions as they enjoy and explore the themes of the story.

MATHS

In maths the children will continue to follow the National Curriculum plans. In addition they will use problem solving and knowledge of money to budget for a round the world trip. They will calculate distances and calculate currency conversions and focus on different time zones.

SCIENCE

Light and electricity – we will cover 2 topics in science. Revisiting electricity and circuits and then spending time on the Physics topic of light. How light travels in straight lines, how we can prove this, how our eyes see and how lights is made of many different colours.
