At Copley Junior School, we are proud to be a member of the Children's University.

The Children's University is an opportunity for children to be rewarded for spending time involved in activities outside school hours. Children record each hour that they complete in an activity at a Children's University Learning Destination in the Children's University 'Passport to Learning'. All learning destinations are accredited by the Children's University and include clubs organised by Copley Junior School as well as many other local clubs for swimming, dance, martial arts etc.


Children are encouraged to work towards national certificates that are issued from the Children's University. Certificates can be awarded up to 1000 hours. The first award starts with the bronze certificate at the Undergraduate level of 30 hours of learning. One of our pupils has just achieved her bronze postgraduate diploma for achieving over 643 hours of extra-curricular learning!
