Roseacres Primary opened in September 2015 in order to serve the growing community of Takeley. During our first year and in consultation with our parents, we formulated our vision statement:

Code of Conduct

Pupil's behaviour and the expected agreed code of conduct was developed in consultation with our pupils. This has been reviewed and improved so that we now have a visual aid to help us remember the three key areas (safety, happiness and learning) and the behaviour choices expected of everyone in order to achieve this. The code forms an essential part of our personal social health and citizenship (PSHCE) education policy and practice.

Our code of conduct is based upon four simple rules that form the basis of our positive behaviour policy. The children were asked to consider what they needed to do in order to **be safe, be happy** and **be able to learn**. By adopting the children's code, we hope that they are able to understand the words, their meaning and their importance for maintaining a harmonious school community. We promote the belief that each child has a responsibility to themselves in achieving the aims of this code, as well as a collective responsibility. We guide and support the pupils to recognise this through the curriculum, e.g. in PSHCE lessons as well as in the social interactions that occur in daily life both inside and outside the classroom.

As adults we aim to model the behaviours that we expect of our pupils by demonstrating respect, kindness, sensitivity, integrity and fairness.
