

Evaluation of SDP 2016-17

We have had another successful year:

- Outstanding assessment results in EYFS - GLD is 87.5% .In 2016 National was 69% , and school was 81% there is no 2017 data yet
- Year 1 phonic screen results were high again with 84% meeting the standard. From the Year 2 re-screens there was an increase from 87% to 95% meeting the standard.(1 child dis-applied)
- Key stage 1 results were outstanding again with very pleasing results in greater depth. In reading 88% were at the expected standard or above (37%GD), In writing 84% at expected or above (29% GD) and in maths 89% at expected or above (39% GD)
- We gained academy status, setting up Vision Learning Trust with the Junior school
- The key stage 1 outdoor classroom was updated, with phase 2 being completed.
- A whole school review was undertaken by a consultant who agreed with our outstanding judgements in our SEF
- LA moderation of EYFS assessments— verified school judgements

Challenges to 2017—2018 include:

- Curriculum re-design—in line with National agendas
- Budget constraints
- Academy conversion - establishing the learning trust
- New staff in leadership and management positions

However there will also be new opportunities:

- Academy conversion and strengthening partnerships
- Phase 3 of the outdoor classroom
- Development of a mental health programme in school

This plan identifies the priorities that are key to whole school improvement and will form the basis for staff appraisals.

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
