1) Introduction and background

Tor Bank After School Club was created to offer those pupils with additional needs the opportunity to access an after school club tailored to meet their individual needs. This service is provided by Tor Bank staff with medical support from a member of the nursing team.

Tor Bank After Schools club is held during term time, on a weekly basis every Monday from 3pm – 4.45pm in Tor Bank School.

2) Youth Club membership

The youth club is open to the following members:-

- Those registered as a pupil at Tor Bank School
- The pupil must either attend the multi-sensory department or is 14years and over and is allocated 1:1 support within school.
- Pupils who have returned a completed registration form

3) Funding

A fee of £45 is requested to help fund all after school club activities. This is broken down to a termly fee of £15 payable at the beginning of each school term (September, January, April). Any small profit generated will go directly back into the club itself to improve resources or services.

It is expected that from time to time it may be necessary to adjust pricing structures. This will always be considered carefully and will normally be the result of inflation.

4) Child Protection

All employees of Tor Bank School are child protection and safeguarding trained. The child protection and safeguarding policy which is applicable to Tor Bank School will be rigorously adhered to at all times.

5) Policies and Procedures

All Tor Bank School policies and procedures will be followed at all times.

6) Parental Responsibility

-Parents are asked to collect their children promptly at 4.50pm. In the event that a child cannot be collected, school staff should be notified on 90484147. Persistent lateness will result in suspension of access to the After Schools Club.

-Parents please note

Tor Bank After Schools club is only accessible to those who are present in school on the day the club is open.

After Schools club will be closed on the first Monday of each term to allow staff preparation and planning time.
