- Use capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences.
- Write demarcated sentences (as an introduction to paragraphs).
- Use pencil grip.
- Write name (correct upper and lower case letters used).
- Use correct letter formation for familiar words.

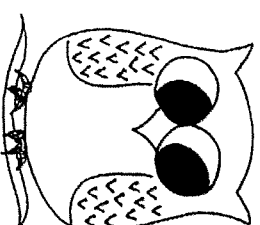
## Reading

- Read some common irregular words ( e.g. the, was, said).
- Use phonic knowledge to decode regular words and read aloud accurately.
- Identify rhymes and alliteration.
- Join in with rhyming patterns.
- Read and understand simple sentences.
- Demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read.
- Make basic predictions.
- Identify the start and end of a sentence.
