### SECONDARY SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

All relevant information about the process will be made available at the meeting.

We anticipate that the meeting should last about 1 hour and request that, if possible, you do not bring children along to the meeting. **The closing date for applications for September 2018 is 31**<sup>st</sup> **October 2017.** 

#### SCHOOL FUND
