It has been great to see the Early Years children settle so well into school and learn their new routines quickly. They have only been with us for two days but some seem so settled, it's like they have always been here!

Please can I ask you that grapes and other pieces of small fruit, such as strawberries and blueberries, are cut up into quarters as they are a choking hazard.

Grapes especially should always be **cut** lengthwise so they can pass more easily through smaller throats - never widthwise, because they will still be big enough to choke on. Due to their softness and shape, whole grapes can block the 'small, tight' airway of a young child.
