Routines

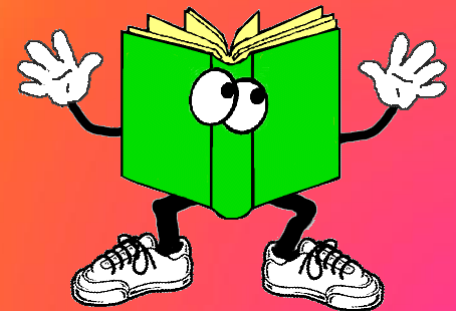
- Fresh water sent in daily in a water bottle with a pop up top please.

 - Some comprehension activities



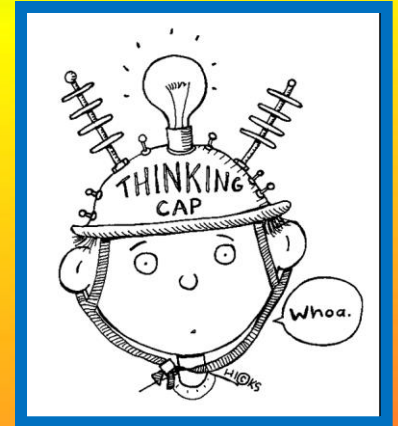
English
