

Welcome and Calling All Volunteers!

PE Kit & Jewellery

School, county and national policy has clear guidelines, for health and safety reasons, that pupils must not wear any form of jewellery in school, with the exception of a wristwatch and small stud/sleeper earrings (which the child must be able to remove themselves). Staff are not allowed to tape up or remove a child's earrings for them.

Although the risk is generally low, injury could occur whenever children are encouraged to be active, including break and lunch times, due to contact with jewellery worn by themselves or another person. I am therefore asking that children do not wear jewellery at school, of any kind, unless they are able to remove it at given times during the school day.

It is also policy that all pupils should have a fully named PE kit in school. This should consist of a plain T-shirt, plain shorts, socks and black plimsolls. Trainers cannot be worn indoors, although they are allowed for outdoor PE. We try to do some PE outdoors, even when it is cold, so your child may be asked to bring a track-suit or sweatshirt to ensure they can keep warm.
