Year 6 Bikeability 2017

IMPORTANT: Due to a number of children taking part needing to borrow a bike this year, the second course on Wednesday and Thursday will take place at Todmorden Fire Station.

As we have 34 children taking part this year, Bikeability will be split over two courses. We have circled below the course dates for your child:

Course 1: Monday 18th and Tuesday 19th September (Venue: **CASTLE HILL PRIMARY SCHOOL**)

Course 2: Wednesday 20th and Thursday 21st September (Venue: **TODMORDEN FIRE STATION**)

Drop off and registration: 8:45am - 9am

Collection at the end of the day: 3:00pm - 3:15pm from the fire station or normal time from school

PLEASE NOTE: Children are not permitted to ride their bike home and must be collected.

On the day your child is required to:

- Bring their bike and helmet to the correct venue (some children have requested a bike and/or helmet which will be provided)
- Take their bike home at the end of the day and bring it back the following day
- Wear suitable clothing and footwear for cycling, including waterproofs and sun-cream if necessary
- Bring a packed lunch (preferably in a rucksack which the children can carry whilst on their bike) including a drink

IMPORTANT: All bikes must be roadworthy which means:

- Tyres fully inflated with no punctures
- Front and rear working brakes
- Bikes which are the correct size for your child

If your child's bike is considered to be not roadworthy by the course instructors, they may not be able to take part on the day.
