A Plan for the Spending of PE Premium 2016-17 (financial year)



Action	Reason	Impact
Dance Teacher – total cost = £7,500 £5,000 from PE fund. Rest funded from other areas of the budget.	Provide dance lessons across the school, mainly in KS1 to ensure curriculum coverage.	Continue with more pupils accessing extra curricular activities. KS1 & KS2 pupils are receiving high quality teaching in dance. KS2 pupils can now access a street dance lunch time club delivered by the teacher. This has led to an increase in the number of girls attending extra curricular activities. This activity improves pupil's fitness, agility, coordination, communication and teamwork skills.
Hollingworth Lake activities day - £500	Provide year 4 pupils with an insight to OAA and give them new experiences. In turn we are hoping to boost the uptake for the Y5 Outdoor Robinwood trip.	All of the pupils accessed activities that they hadn't before. Following on from the trip all but 4 out of 60 children attended the Robinwood OAA trip. This is a huge improvement on last year's numbers. This activity takes pupils outside of their comfort zone and improves communication and teamwork skills.
Lacrosse lessons in PE curriculum - £290	Intensive week of coaching.	All pupils across the school received expert tuition from qualified coaches. This will improve skills and give access to new activities.
Gymnastics Coach - £580	Provide an after school club for KS1 to ensure they are benefitting from the PE premium money	More pupils are accessing extra curricular activities. Prior to this coach being sourced only KS2 pupils could access extra curricular sports clubs. A teaching assistant was present at the sessions allowing higher numbers and also improving their knowledge of the sport which they could pass on to the pupils. This activity improves pupil's fitness, agility, coordination, balance and flexibility.
Fitness testing with Amaven - £1000	Fitness measuring activities conducted at points in the year to demonstrate that levels of pupil fitness are improving	Amaven run the tests, in conjunction with PE coordinator which provides an analysis of the performance data which provides a comparison with prior fitness levels.
Transport - £300	Transport pupils to and from sports fixtures.	This money gave pupils the opportunity to use the skills they have learnt in lessons and extra curricular clubs against similar aged pupils from local primary schools.
Man City Football Coaching - £600	Provides additional after school activity throughout the year	More pupils are accessing extra curricular activities. Year 3 & 4 pupil's football skills are improving as they are having more contact time with the coach. Previously year 3,4,5 & 6 all had football club on the same night. This activity improves pupil's fitness, agility, coordination, communication & teamwork skills.
Annual MPSSA Subs - £80 Payment for 2 years.	This money goes towards the running of competitions in a wide variety of sports against local schools.	This money gave pupils the opportunity to use the skills they have learnt in lessons and extra curricular clubs against similar aged pupils from local primary schools. *See attached documents for a list of events
Equipment - £1000	Equipment has been bought/replaced.	Both curriculum and extra curricular sports can be taught to a higher standard with the new equipment.
Daily Run - £500	Equipment which promotes and supports the Daily Run	Purchase of incentives and devices to measure heart rate etc which will encourage pupils in their daily activity.
Link4Life activities - £0	To enhance the provision in Breakfast Club – 45 minutes sessions 1 per week for 12 weeks	Provides additional day of activities for BC pupils, in addition to the activities on other days, PE and Art.
