PARKING and CONGESTION

It has come to my attention from parents, local residents and the building site next door to the infant site that parking is a problem. We are all united in our concern about childrens safety. I would like to propose a solution; I have contacted Tesco and being very supportive of the local community, they have kindly offered their car park as a safe place to park.

This solution means;

- We are keeping our children safe
- Healthier children and good role models
- A chance to talk to your child about what they have been learning at school
- We are saving the environment and your child will receive their WOW walking badge
- We are respecting our community and their ability to be able to access their houses



I appreciate that lives are busy (I am a busy Mum too, I get it!) but if all parents who normally drive onto the estates aspire to park in Tesco's car park 3 times per week, as a minimum it would make a huge difference. 😊



NOTE: Redrow homes are concerned for our children's safety. It is a building site and is not officially a public highway until it has been 'signed off' and is no longer a building site. Their concerns are genuine and for the best of our children.

Late Arrival at SCHOOL

When your child arrives late at school, he/she misses the teacher's instructions and the introduction to the lesson.

Your child may also feel embarrassed at having to enter the classroom late
Minutes late per day during the school year= Equals days worth of teaching lost in a year

- 5 Minutes= 3.4 Days
- 10 Minutes= 6.9 Days
- 15 Minutes= 10.3 Days
- 20 Minutes= 13.8 Days
- 30 Minutes= 20.7 Days

Frequent lateness can add up to a considerable amount of learning lost, and can seriously disadvantage your child.

School begins at 8:30am infant site and 8.50am junior site on. Please help your child to be punctual.
