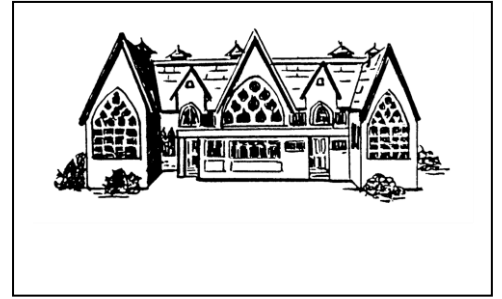


# West Vale Primary School

## Preventing Radicalisation



As part of West Vale Primary School's commitment to safeguarding and child protection we fully support the government's Prevent Strategy.

### What is the Prevent Strategy?

The Prevent strategy is a government strategy designed to stop people becoming terrorists or supporting terrorism. It:

- responds to the ideological challenge we face from terrorism and aspects of extremism, and the threat we face from those who promote these views
- provides practical help to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism and ensure they are given appropriate advice and support
- works with a wide range of sectors (including education, criminal justice, faith, charities, online and health)

### Responsibility

**The lead person responsible for the Prevent Strategy at West Vale Primary is**

**Mr C Wightman, Executive Headteacher.**

All the staff at West Vale Primary have received Prevent training in 2017. The members of the Senior Leadership Team and those who have completed Designated Safeguarding Lead training, all understand the expectations and key priorities to deliver the Prevent Strategy. If Mr Wightman is not in school, staff should refer the concern to a Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL).

The Prevent Strategy is part of our Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy and is also included in our E-Safety policy.

### Reporting Mechanism

**If staff members have a concern regarding radicalisation, they will report it through the normal safeguarding process; by recording the incident on CPOMS which will alert the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL).
