Actual impact

Over 90% of our children have had the opportunity to compete in a sporting event this year.

The teachers' capability and confidence has increased over the year.

This has enabled the staff to arrange and the children to participate in nearly all events and share best practice across the cluster.

The bronze ambassadors have organised multi-skills and other different events within school.

The children have had the opportunity to experience different sports and the teachers have received training.

This has enabled us to compete in various cluster events.

We have taken part in the majority of locality competitions and the children have enjoyed a number of successes.

Children report that they enjoyed the experiences particularly taking part in new sports. Parents enquired as to whether these clubs would run again in future.

The children have enjoyed participation due to high quality new equipment.

All the children achieved their 25 metres length.
