

Numeracy Catch Up Premium Funding report **Autumn 2017**

This year the Year 7 Catch Up Premium Funding was allocated to developing Big Maths and Little Big Maths. This included Big Maths CLIC books and Little Big Maths A-CLIC books for teachers, a 'Jingles' resource for learning additional and multiplication facts, and the Beat That Maths Challenges resource. The Jingles and Challenges resources are accessible to all teachers through the CSE platform. The Jingles resource has proved to be a very effective resource for auditory learners. The Beat That Maths Challenges have provided evidence for progress and given pupils and staff a clear indication of 'next steps'.

The **2016 – 2017** Year 7 cohort made outstanding progress over the year.

- Teachers in this cohort were positive about implementing the Big Maths approach.
- There were 13 pupils in this group, 11 (85%) of which either met or exceed their Number targets.
- 5 pupils (38%) exceeded their targets in Number.

The **2017 – 2018** Year 7 cohort comprises 11 pupils, none of whom are in Access classes, 2 are currently in the 'Booster' Class and 2 are new pupils. Last year our Year 7's made outstanding progress. The range of ability this year is from P7 – 2c (Addington levels). There was 1 pupil who was identified as not meeting their Number target, and 1 pupil who made less than expected progress in Using and Applying and Shape, Space and Measures last year

Therefore, this year's Numeracy Catch Up Premium Funding will be spent on Number/Money resources to further support progress in Number and Using and Applying.

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
