Our home / school links	Hold 2 parent's evenings a year. Hold one open evening a year. Provide a written report annually. Hold regular opportunities for parents to come into school, promoting an open door ethos wherever possible.	Talk to my parents about school and share my successes and mistakes. Take letters home and invite my parents in to special events.	Encourage a positive attitude towards my child's education and our school. If I have any concerns, I will discuss them with you in person and not on social media, as this is a healthier way to work out solutions & move on. Attend parent meetings & support PTA events. Share relevant information with school.
Our behaviour	Promote and reward good behaviour through our STARS system. Tackle inappropriate behaviour when needed quickly.	Follow the school and class rules. Try hard to be polite, kind and helpful to everyone. Exhibit STARS behaviours. Be responsible for my actions.	Talk about the STARS characters and behaviours with your child. Encourage children to behave appropriately at all times and promote kindness to others.
Our use of the internet	Ensure filters are in place to protect children from viewing inappropriate content. Teach children about internet safety, including cyber bullying and social media. Encourage children to talk to an adult if they are worried.	Listen carefully in internet safety lessons. Never say unkind things to others on the internet. Never arrange to meet someone from the internet. Tell an adult if anything worries you when you are using the internet.	Talk to our children about internet safety to echo messages from school. Encourage responsible use of the internet at home eg: do not allow unsupervised access to the internet without filters. Encourage children to talk to an adult if anything worries them while using the internet.
Our attendance and punctuality	Check attendance regularly and contact parents with any concerns.	Attend school every day (unless I'm unwell) and on time.	Notify school in the event of illness by 9.30am. Ensure child attends regularly and on time. Refrain from taking holidays in term time.
