

Term 1 Plan for Year Three and Four September/October 2017

History

The children will learn about the history of castles and their development in British history with a focus on Warwick Castle.

Geography

Locate and research castles in different countries.
Use maps and digital/computer mapping to locate and plan a route to a destination.

Maths

The children will:

- Revise and build on their knowledge and understanding of place value.
- Continue to learn their times tables and apply these to problems.
- Ordering and comparing numbers.
- Finding 1, 10, 100 and 1000 more or less of a given number.
- Counting up in 25s or 50s.

English

The children will:

- Explore and become familiar with myths and legends.
- Retell texts orally and discuss conventions of different texts.
- Use organizational devices, read and retrieve information from a range of texts.
- As editors, proof read for spelling and punctuation errors.
- To plan, draft and write a comic strip based on a myth and legend.
- Write for different audiences.
- Write a set of instructions for the making and firing of a trebuchet.

Music - Listening and appraising pop songs of the 70s.

The children will plan, design and create their own working trebuchets using wood.
