Visit to Brockwell Woods, Blaydon Friday 29 September 2017

We have arranged for Year 5 to visit Brockwell Woods on Friday 29 September 2017.

At the woods, children will have the opportunity to play and explore the woodland environment. The theme of the day is Beowulf and the activities we will be doing during the day include den building, scavenger hunt, developing survival skills and problem solving. The cost of this forest adventure is £4.

Camp food will be provided on the day. Children may bring a packed lunch if they prefer.

Children will need to wear clothes suitable for the weather such as warm clothes and have a coat, wellies, gloves, hats and scarfs in case of inclement weather. Children will need additional socks to keep their feet warm. It is better for children to wear layered clothing as layers can be removed if necessary. If the weather is to be sunny then a cap and sun cream would be appropriate - please note that children should wear long sleeves and long trousers to protect against the woodland environment.

Children need to be in school for **8.30am** on the day of this visit. Please arrive through the main school entrance and your child will be collected by their class teachers.

We are sure the children will thoroughly enjoy themselves.
