School council have created their own action plan for the year ahead. The first request was Discos, they will be writing an article soon telling you more about this. The discos have been booked and the dates are in the dates section.

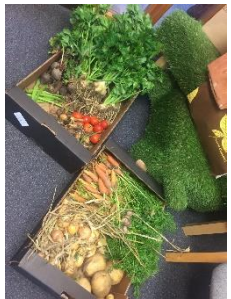

### Late Arrival at SCHOOL

When your child arrives late at school, he/she misses the teacher's instructions and the introduction to the lesson.

Your child may also feel embarrassed at having to enter the classroom late  
**Minutes late per day during the school year= Equals days worth of teaching lost in a year**

- 5 Minutes= 3.4 Days
- 10 Minutes= 6.9 Days
- 15 Minutes= 10.3 Days
- 20 Minutes= 13.8 Days
- 30 Minutes= 20.7 Days

Frequent lateness can add up to a considerable amount of learning lost, and can seriously disadvantage your child.

School begins at 8:30am on the infant site and 8.50am on the junior site.  
**Please help your child to be punctual.**
