As part of our journey to be a Rights Respecting School we are engaging a project which we hope will help all children and families to learn more about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.

Each key group has their own bear which they have named.



Every child in the group will have the opportunity to take the bear home once every half term. Coming home with the bear will be a printed card with one of the Articles printed out for your family to keep. This Article will be the one the room teams have chosen to talk to the children about during that half term. For example in the Spring term the children were learning about every child's right to nutritious food (Article 24). There were age appropriate activities taking place across the school to support the children's learning and understanding.
