

# A Message from Redlands Road Safety Team

Dear Parents

The Road Safety Team have had their first meeting of the year today and unfortunately it is on a sad note that we have to inform you that 4 parents received a parking fine on Thursday for parking inconsiderately outside of school. There will be a patrolling car from Nottinghamshire County Council, with CCTV patrolling the area to help discourage dangerous and inconsiderate parking. Motorist caught parking on restricted areas near school or in bus stops will be issued with a Penalty Charge3 Notice (PCN) of £70.

The message is clear: DO NOT PARK ON **SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR** MARKINGS!

Our road safety team want to keep the roads around school as safe as possible and have come up with these points to improve the safety of everyone at Redlands.

- Use car parks provided in the local area, such as: B & Q, Wickes and John Street.
- Parents, you must park in safe places.
- It is not acceptable to drop off children on the zig zag lines.
- Don't block the entrance to our school car park in case we need the emergency services.
- Keep us safe!
- Walk on the pavements; not the road!
- Double parking causes road blockages, especially for school buses returning from trips or for emergency vehicles gaining access to the residents.
- Please do not let your children get out of your car without adult supervision. Park safely and walk them into school.
- Try car sharing to cut down the numbers of cars coming to school.
- Walk to school (if possible) to cut down on pollution and potential accidents.
- Your actions are potentially causing accidents, injuries and fatalities, so please park considerably.
