Pupil Premium

It couldn't be simpler to check your child's eligibility.

All that is needed is for you, as parents and carers, to provide just four pieces of information to your child's school directly on their admission form.

- > **Your Name**
- > **Your Date of Birth**
- > **Your National Insurance Number**
- > **A signed declaration**

This will be securely passed to the Education Welfare Benefits (EWB) service who will check entitlement.

The funding ranges from £935 for secondary age children, and £1,300 for primary age children, and this is currently payable for 6 years. Your child's school will use this money to support your child and help them to do well at school. The school will keep records and monitor how the money has had an impact.

Next step: Get in contact with the school to ask for their admission form, so the check can be made.
