Bisley Basics: Family Learning

At Bisley we like to open our doors to parents/grandparents as often as we can. We believe it is important for you to be as involved as possible with your child's education and as a school we try and provide many varied opportunities for this to happen.

During the first week of each month we hold our Family Learning Sessions. Each month these take on slightly varying forms and include family lunches, invitations to assemblies, parent workshops and time with your child at playtime or in the classroom. This gives parents and carers an opportunity to experience first-hand what primary school life is like and helps set your child's learning in context. Some of these sessions are suitable for pre-school children to attend but due to the nature of school many are not suitable. If this is the case we will always make this clear to you in advance.

We aim to offer two Family Lunches during the Family Learning week, with one towards the beginning and one towards the end of the week. Parents and grandparents are very welcome to come to a lunch. You will need to **book and pay for your meal in advance of the day** – details will be on the newsletter. Please arrive at school for midday on the day of the lunch where a Year 6 will take you to your child's class to collect your child and you will then both go to the school hall for lunch. If your child has a packed lunch you are welcome to bring a packed lunch from home or purchase a school meal. Regrettably we cannot accommodate pre-school children at our lunches.
