## English

## Maths

Place value.

Read and write numbers in numerals and words. Recognise the place value of each digit in a three/four digit number.

Partition numbers in different ways. Order and compare numbers. Identify numbers on a number line. Compare and order numbers. Rounding numbers. Mental calculations for addition and subtraction. Decimal numbers. Find 0.1, 1, 1.0, 100 or 1000 more or less than a given number. Count up and down in hundredths. Solve practical problems involving all of the above. Money, rounding decimals.

2D shape, angles, perimeter. Addition and subtraction.

Inverse operations. Problem solving. Bar charts and tables.

Written methods for addition and subtraction. Time.
