

Maths

We will be focusing on:

- Counting and place value.
- Reading and writing numbers to 20.
- Solving addition and subtraction problems.
- Properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Religious Education

The children will take part in Harvest Festival at Church.

The children will be considering questions such as "Who is God?" "What is the Bible about?" and "Why do people give presents at Christmas?"

Literacy

Key Text 1 - I will not ever never eat a tomato

Lola eats food if Charlie gives it a different name. Children will taste tomatoes and other fruits and form an opinion recording this in the form of a list.

Key Text 2- Handa's Surprise

Handa wants to take a basket of tangerines to her friend but loses them along the way and African animals are involved. We will sequence the story and use adjectives to describe the fruit.

Key Text 3 - It's disgusting and I ate it

Non fiction book about unusual food around the world. We will learn to use features of a non fiction text and write our own text about an unusual food. We will make smoothies and write instructions.

Geography

Children will find out about different food grown in the UK and around the world. We will locate the places on maps. There will be a trip to Tesco to buy ingredients to make smoothies, buy the fruit in Handa's story and note all the different places they are grown.

Food Around the World Year 1 Autumn Term 1

History

We will look at how the harvest was brought in during the 1900s compared with now (link with RE).

Computing

We will use programs such as 2 Paint to create pictures and learn to use the tools effectively.

Extra Information

Phonics will take place on a daily basis and children will be in differentiated phonics groups.

Science

The children will use their senses to examine different foods and will make a booklet about the five senses. They will be tasting a variety of foods and finding out how these foods grow.

Music

The children will use percussion instruments to create their own rhythmic patterns. We will look at dynamics and how to use our voices expressively.

PSHE and SEAL

We will be exploring different feelings and learning to express them. Children will devise a set of class rules and will learn about "New Beginnings".

DT

The children will use a variety of materials and will construct different models.

Art

The children will use sketch books to draw and fruit and vegetables and illustrate parts of Handa's Surprise.

P.E.

Dance - creative movement connected to the story of Handa's Surprise. Outdoor team games.
