

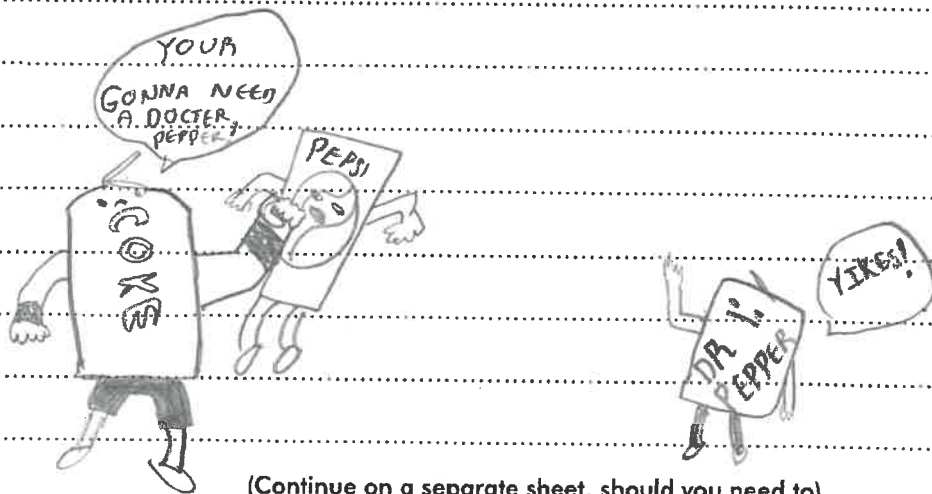
Poem Title: DRINK COKE OR BE A SAD BLOKE!

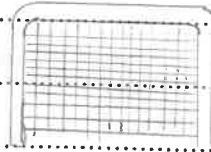

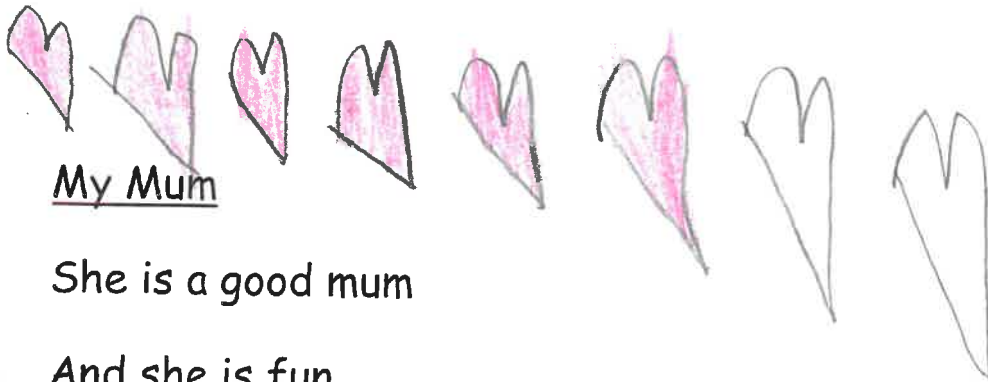
