Pupil Premium funding and the benefits of applying for free school meals.

You may be aware that schools can receive additional funding for all pupils **from reception to year 6** who are registered for statutory Free School Meals. This funding is known as the pupil premium grant.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, already receive free meals under the 'Universal Free School Meals' programme **but this entitlement is different to the Statutory Free School Meals, therefore the children will not benefit from pupil premium grant unless you apply.**

The benefits

Some of the benefits for your child include; a reduction in price for breakfast club, free school trips, free milk, support with uniform, a reduction to the cost of sport after school clubs, opportunities to access small group and 1:1 tuition and other bespoke provision that your child may require.

Are your children eligible?

Free School Meals and Pupil Premium is available to children whose parents/carers are in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (but are not entitled to a Working Tax Credit and your annual income is below £16,190)
- Support under Part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Universal Credit
