Road Safety ~ Putting the Children First

Once again the parking issues around school are causing us all a problem. Please be considerate to our neighbours, each other, and most importantly, our children. Please do not park immediately outside the school gates in Atlantic Drive or in Wade Close or on the corners of Quebec & Galveston Close. **Please DO NOT park in front of drives or garages, it has been a serious inconvenience to our neighbours.**

Because of this children cannot see if the road is clear from behind parked cars. Drivers cannot see small children hidden by parked cars.

Zig-zag markings are there for a purpose – to provide a clear area in which children can cross more safely.

Please do not park, or wait, on the yellow zig-zag lines outside school. It is an offence to do so, but more importantly it is a safety hazard for your child and other children.

When children go to and from school, there is usually a lot of traffic. If you have to drive your child to school do not park on the zig-zag lines.

Electronically Controlled Safeguarding Pedestrian Gates

As of Friday 29th September 2017, we changed the timings on the pedestrian gates after advice from East Sussex County Council.

As of tomorrow the gates will open as normal at 8.40 am, registration closes at 8.55 am and the gates will close at this time instead of 9.10 am.

Please can we respectfully remind all parents entering or leaving the school via the electronic pedestrian gates to not allow any visitors or parents access to the school unless they have been buzzed in by the school staff.

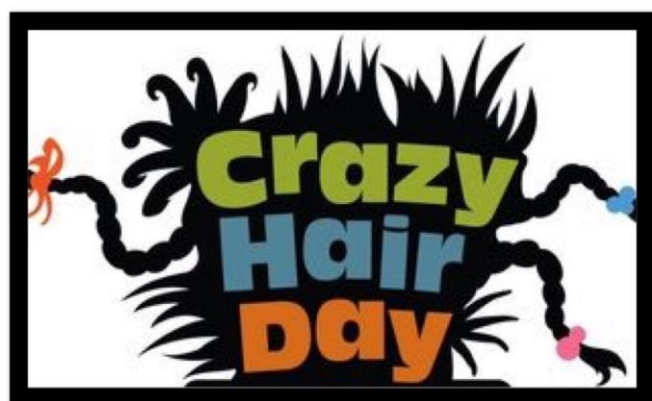
