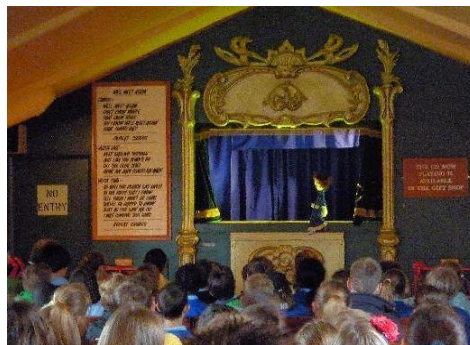

## Y5/6 Eden Camp Trip



On Tuesday Years 5 and 6 were transported back to wartime Britain. They went on a trip to Eden Camp in Malton, a museum of World War II, based in what was a prisoner of war camp. The museum takes a chronological look at the war, and exhibits are housed in the huts used during the prison camp days. We experienced the sights, the sounds and even the smells of those dangerous times. With every hut we went to, there were new stories to be discovered. The museum includes everything from aircraft and vehicles to gas masks and ration books. It tells the stories of troops and their families left at home, of POW's and politicians. There is a huge collection of medals, with moving stories of the recipients bravery. Before entering huts, children were given tasks and they all raced to complete them first. Whilst we felt quite sad and emotional at times looking at some of the exhibits, we also found some funny moments. We all did a sing along with Vera Lynn, George Formby and other famous stars of the 40s. We particularly enjoyed hearing Mr Towler singing along. Eden Camp Music Hall showed us a typical wartime production with a difference. The characters were actually puppets. We had a wonderful and very educational day out of school. We felt like we were taking part in history.
