

# CAPITAL LETTERS

## A sentence:

- \* starts with a capital letter
- \* ends with a . ? !
- \* makes complete sense

- Capital letters are used:
- ✓ at the beginning of sentences
  - ✓ for days of the week and months of the year, e.g. **Monday, April**
  - ✓ for names of things, people, places and titles, e.g. **Jack, Samsung, Leicester, Newstead Road, Star Wars**
  - ✓ for abbreviations, e.g. **BBC, RSPCA**

- **full stop** shows the end of a **statement**, e.g. **I like swimming.**

Three punctuation marks can show the end of a sentence.

# SENTENCE ENDINGS

**question mark** shows the end of a **question**, e.g. **Where are you?**

**exclamation mark** shows

- \* raised voice, e.g. **Run!**
- \* strong feelings, e.g. **I can't believe you just said that!**
- \* an **exclamation**, e.g. **What a great answer!**
