



The impact of Sports Premium funding spending at Packington Church of England Primary School

- Children affected by the funding are participating in more activities.
- Children who cannot attend after-school clubs are able to come to sports partnership lunchtime clubs
- We are able to offer well-attended before and after-school clubs - for example, hockey, multi-sports, football, basketball, dodgeball, athletics, cricket
- More children are joining these clubs.
- Children are able to take part in a broader range of activities - e.g new age curling, boccia., cycling, tennis
- We are benefiting from shared resources across the schools' partnership
- CPD - teachers are more confident in their teaching, given their earning through involvement in sports partnership activities and support from NWLSSP coaches. This is making spending of the sports premium sustainable as staff transfer their improved skills and knowledge into their own teaching.
- We are able to plan to prepare children for participation in competitive events within and beyond the sports partnership
- We have achieved the Gold Kitemark
