School Improvement	To agree and recommend to the GB the Learning Improvement Plan (LIP)
	To ensure that Self Evaluation is carried out at least annually
	To prepare a schedule for monitoring the progress of the LIP and to ensure that the full GB receives regular progress reports
	To take an active role in monitoring activities in the school
	To have a working knowledge of RAISEONLINE data for the school
Curriculum	To recommend new and revised policies for ratification to the full GB
	To monitor and review the school's curriculum policy and practice
	To approve and monitor the schools systems for assessment and tracking of pupils
	To ensure that staff set pupil achievement targets and monitor progress towards these
	Receive reports on standards across the school in Reading, Writing and Maths. Including SATs results, plus statistics regarding CVA and RAISEOnline data.
	To carry out the GB responsibilities in relation to children with special educational needs (SEN)
	Monitor the use and impact of Pupil Premium spending on children's attainment
