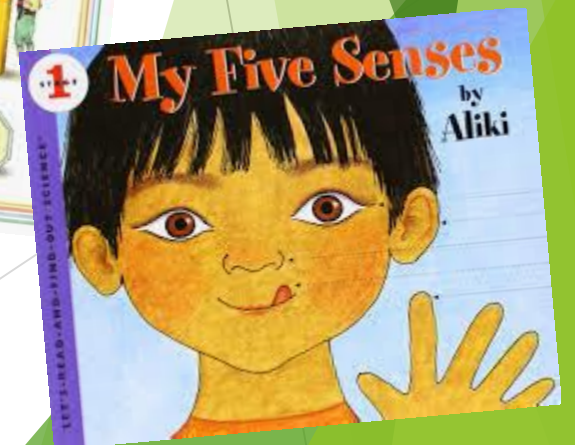
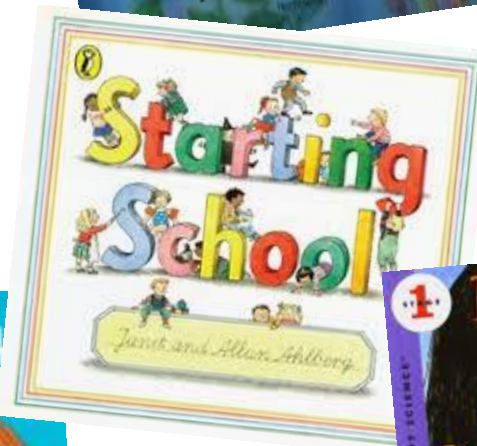
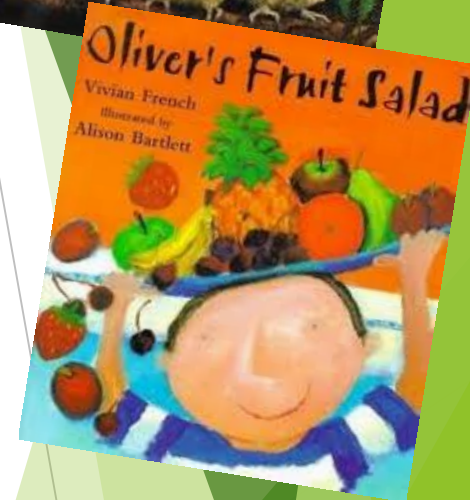
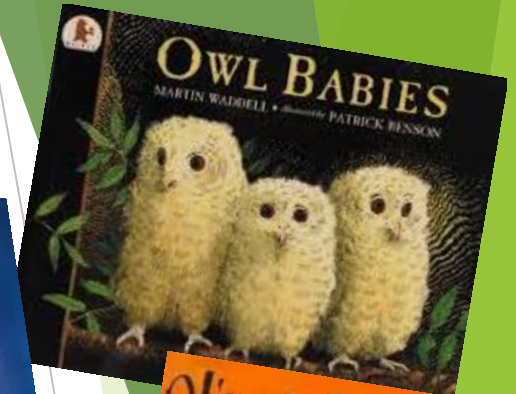
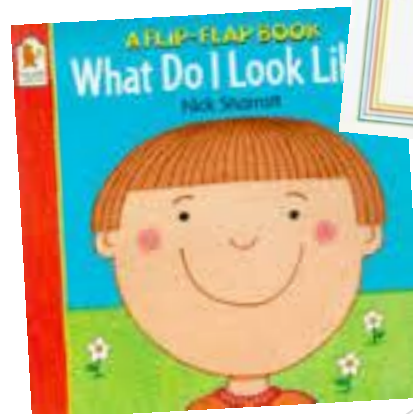
Let's Engage!

- ▶ to use some paint programmes on the computers



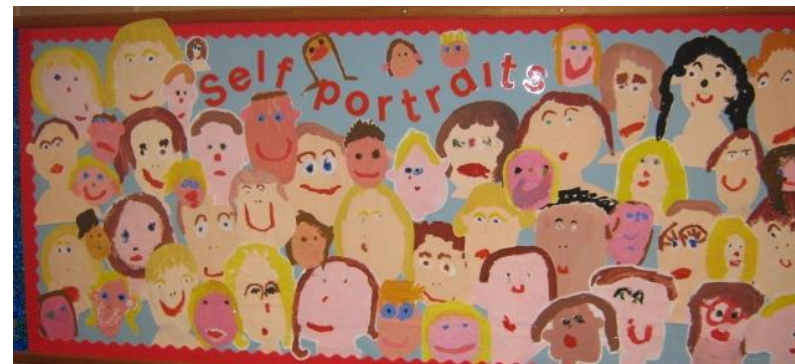
Let's Go Global!
