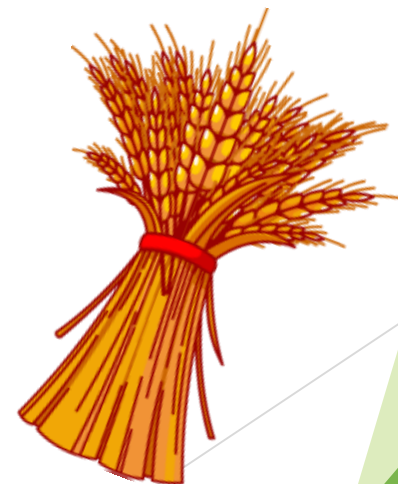


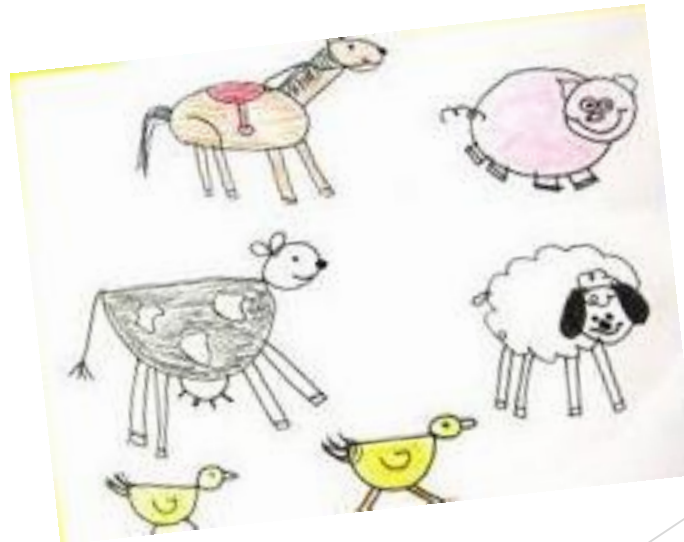

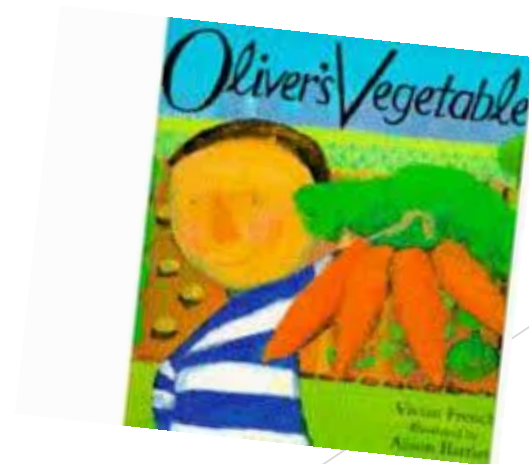
Let's Engage!

Linking Mathematics to our theme we will...

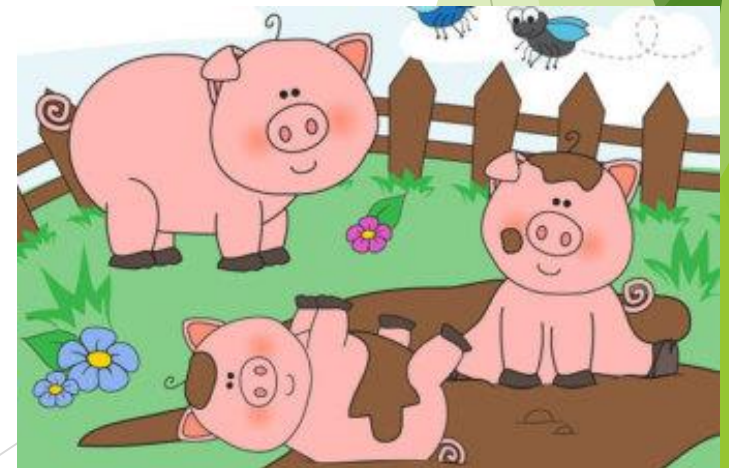
- ▶ we will learn to solve problems using our number knowledge.

- ▶ We will be learning and singing lots of farm themed songs.



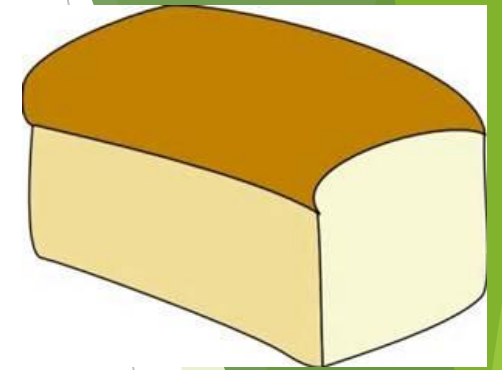
In Computing we will learn about...
