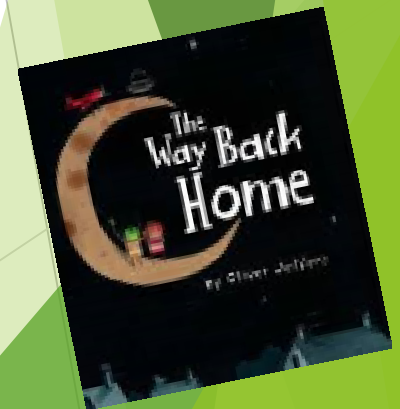
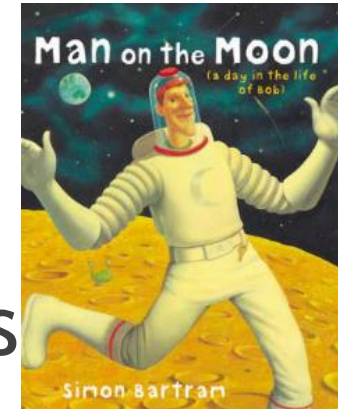
SPACE EXPLORATION

- ▶ The Big Book of Stars and Planets - non-fiction text



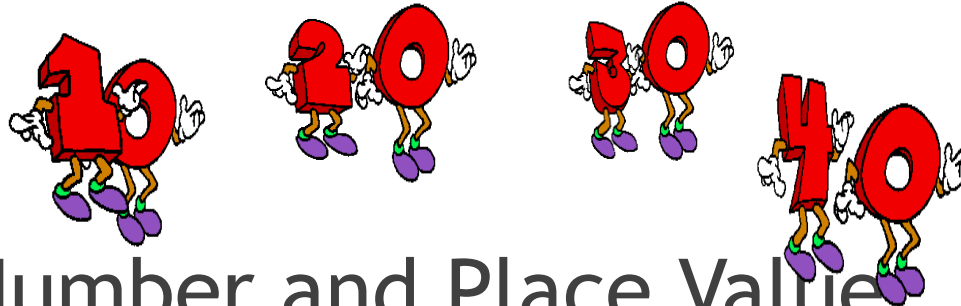
In Literacy we will learn...

In Science we will learn ...



- ▶ to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.
- ▶ how to carry out lots of tests to investigate the properties of materials i.e. sinking and floating and using magnets.
- ▶ to identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock.
- ▶ to describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.

- ▶ Linked to Science we will be learning all about materials and the effect some materials are having on the planet.
- ▶ We will be looking at 'Saving Water' and 'Recycling'.



Let's Get Creative!

- To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space by marbling planets.

- ▶ Using these programs to create pictures and write captions.



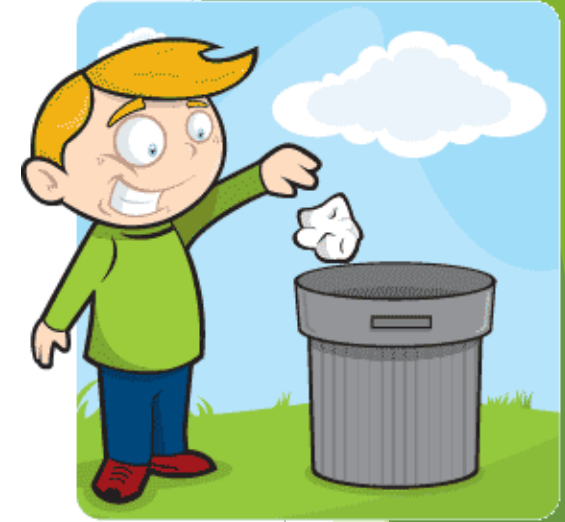
When learning about religions we will...
