Reading at home

As you will be aware, we encourage everyone in nursery and school to take books home to share and read. In school there is a prize system to encourage reading at home. Every time a child reads 10 times (recorded in their reading diary) they can choose a small prize from the 'Golden Box' in Mrs Boddy's office. When they have read 50 times they can choose a book to keep and a certificate is presented in assembly. There are displays in the corridor so you can see how far children are along the challenge.



Each time a child reads in school also counts towards the challenge. Lots of children have already collected prizes this term. There are still some children, however, who have not had their first prize yet. We want to encourage everyone to read at home each day and bring their reading diary to school every day so it can be checked and prizes given. If you have any questions about reading then please talk to your child's class teacher.
