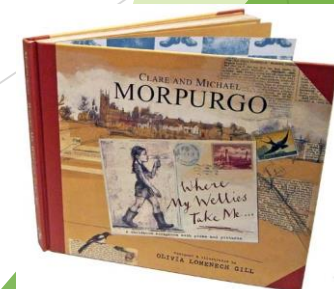
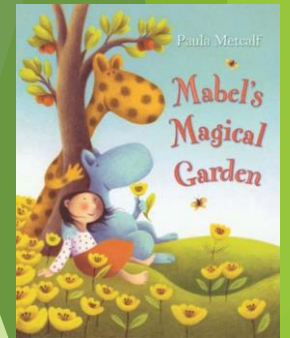
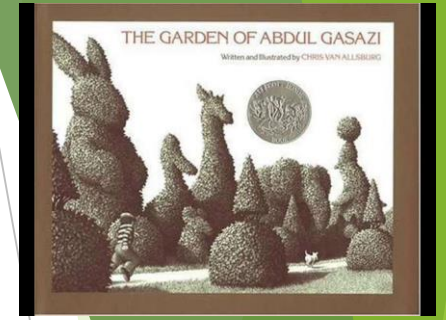
Let's Engage!

- ▶ to identify features of poetry and include them in our c

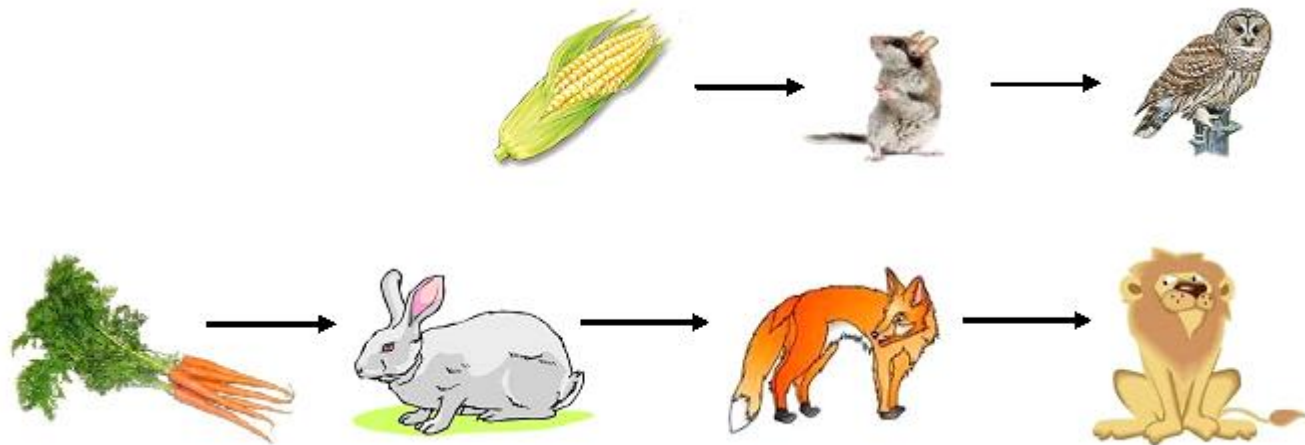


Linking Mathematics to our theme we will...
