- ▶ to recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matters.



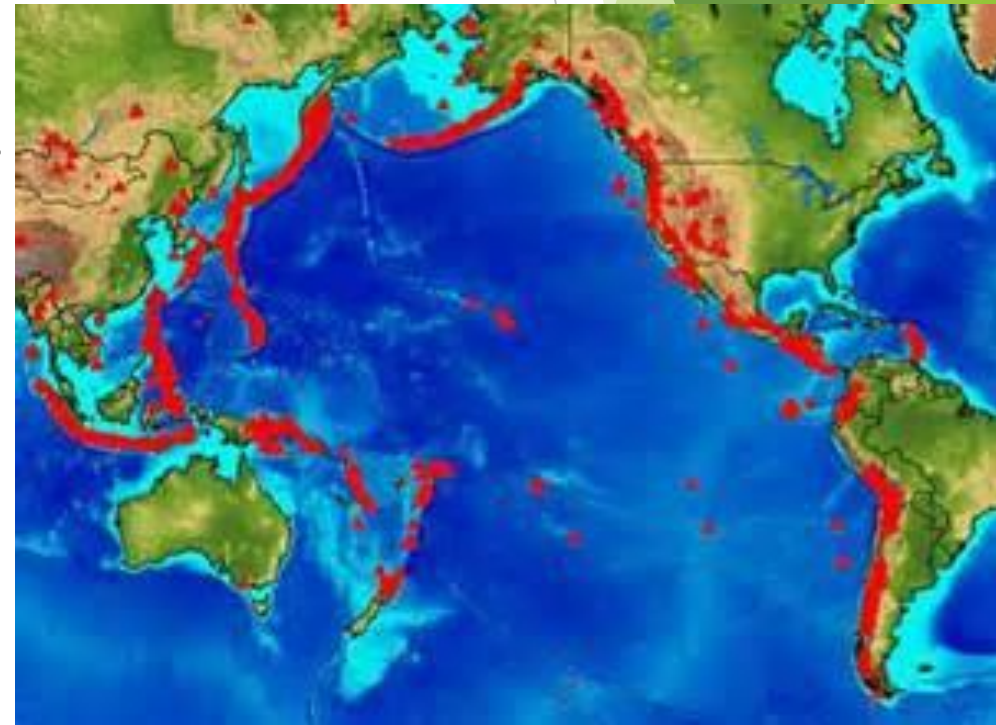
Let's Go Global!
