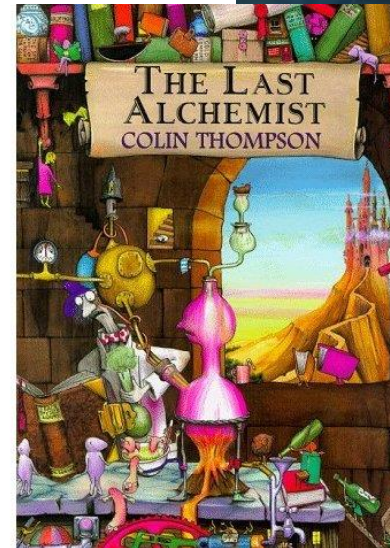
Let's Engage!

In Literacy we will learn...

Linking Mathematics to our theme we will be...

- ▶ investigating temperature
- ▶ calculating through Science experiments
- ▶ finding fractions of amounts of ingredients

In Science we will learn ...

- ▶ to compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.
- ▶ to observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius ($^{\circ}\text{C}$)
- ▶ to identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.
