Lets Engage

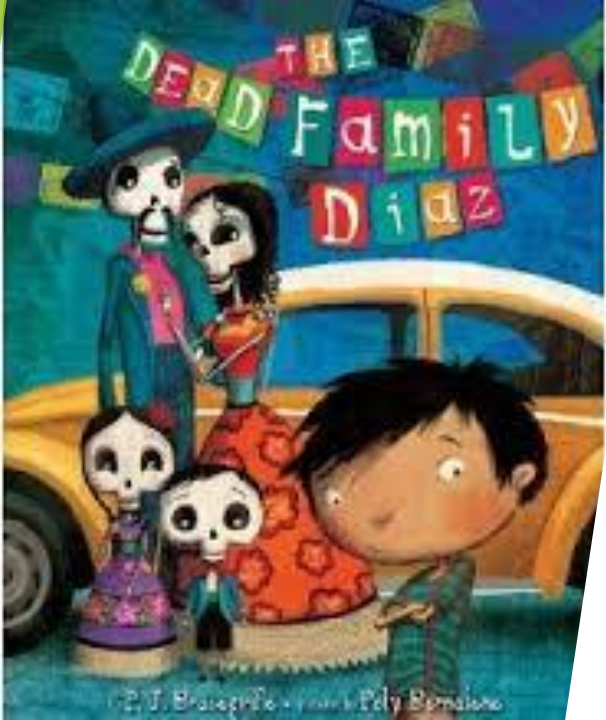


- ▶ We are having a Mexican day!
