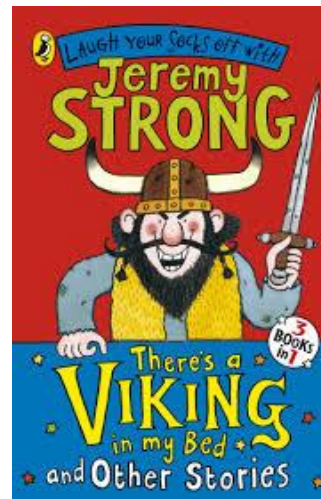
Let's Engage!

- ▶ Asterix and Obelix comics

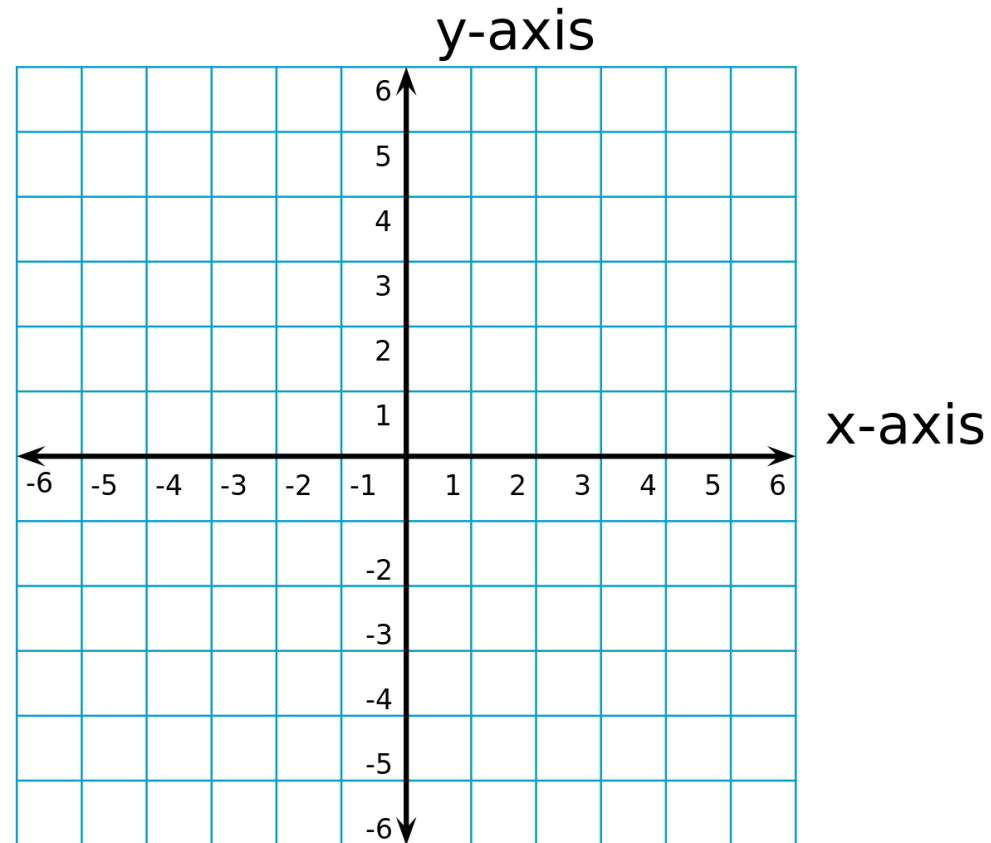


In English we will learn...

Linking Mathematics to our theme we will...

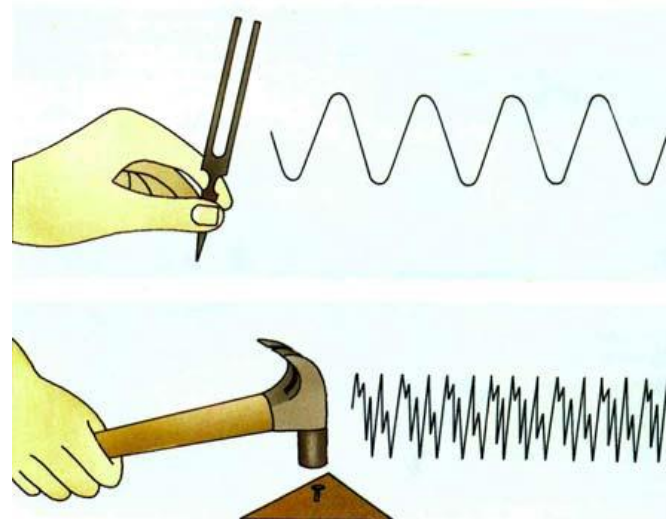
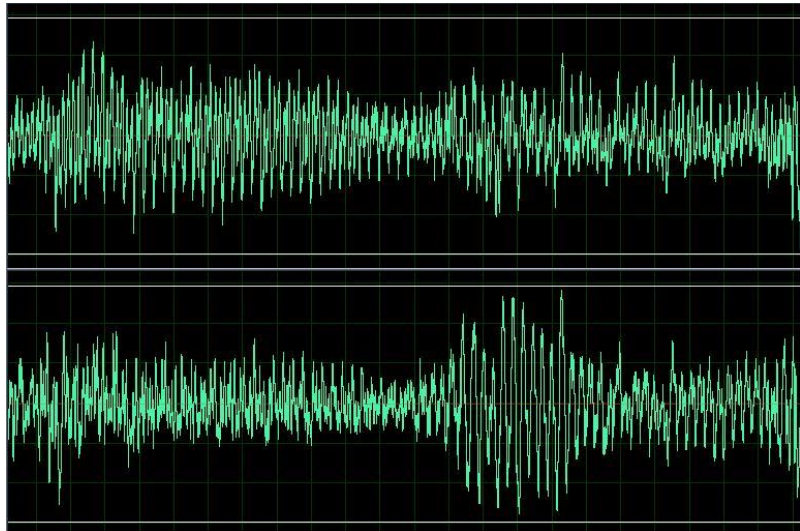
- ▶ Learn about co-ordinates.



In Science we will learn ...

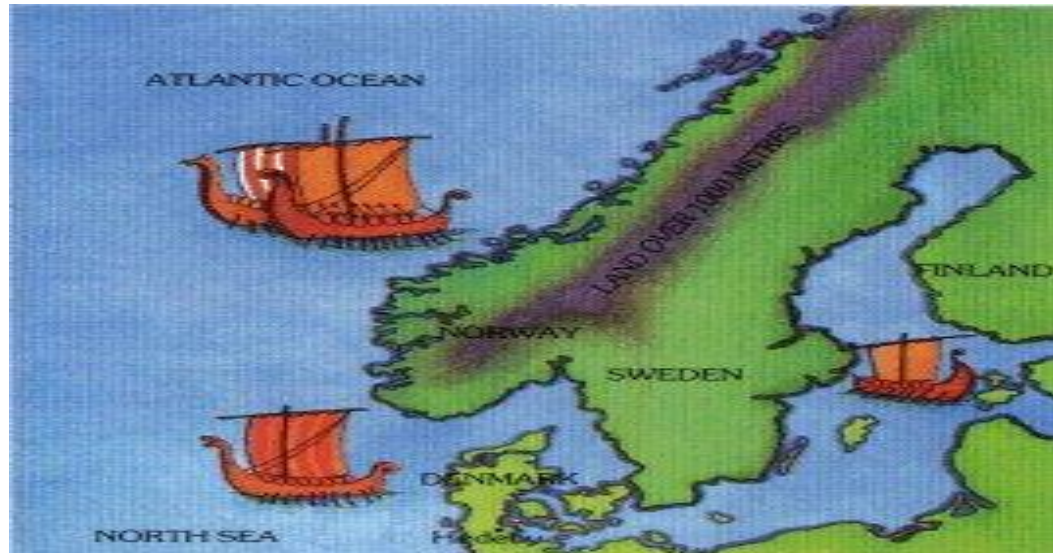


- ▶ To identify how sounds are made, how it travels and how it can be changed.
