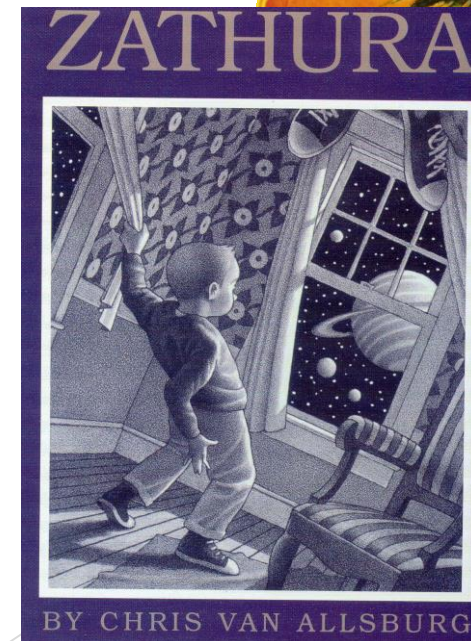
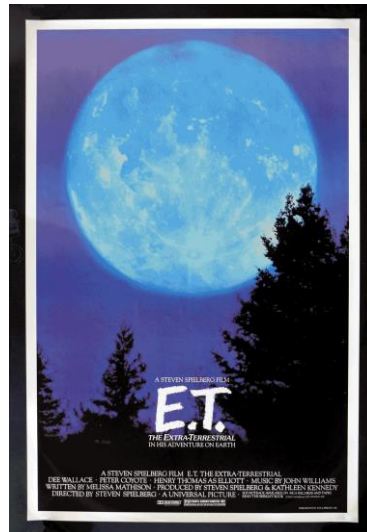
Let's Engage!

- ▶ Come and enjoy gazing at the moon and stars in our giant planetarium.



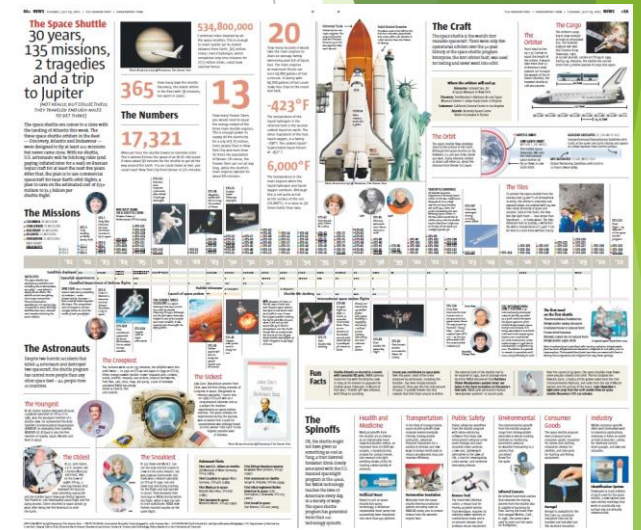
We will use these books and film clips to help us learn...

- ▶ to create holiday brochures and or postcards.

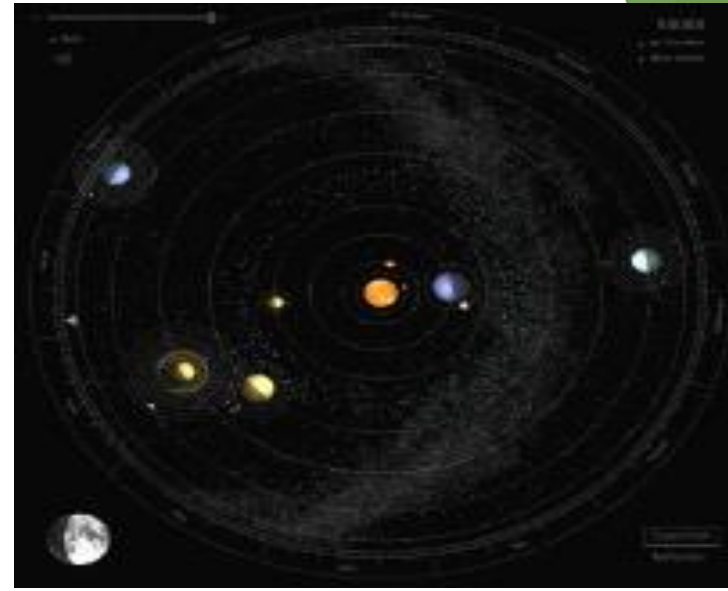


Linking Mathematics to our theme we will...
