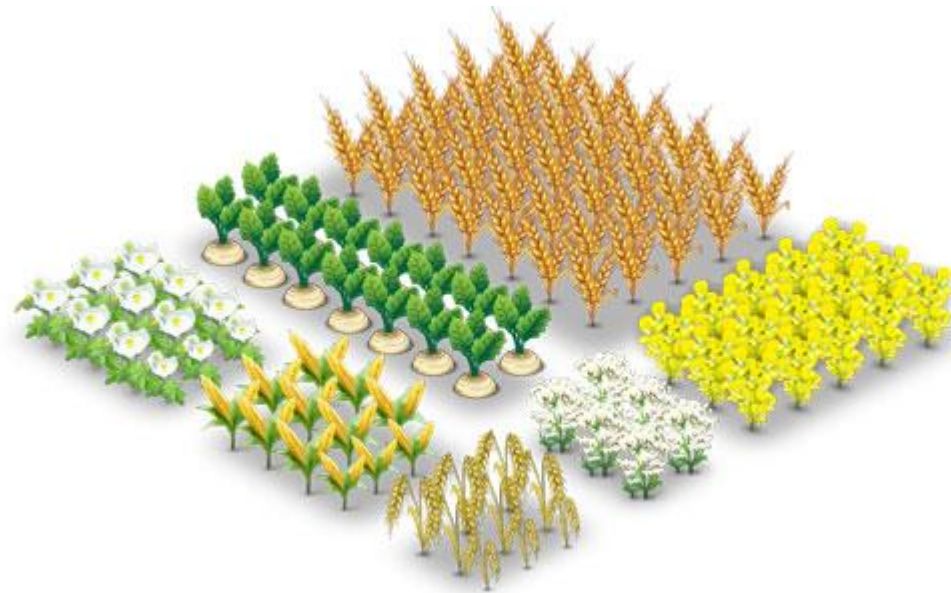

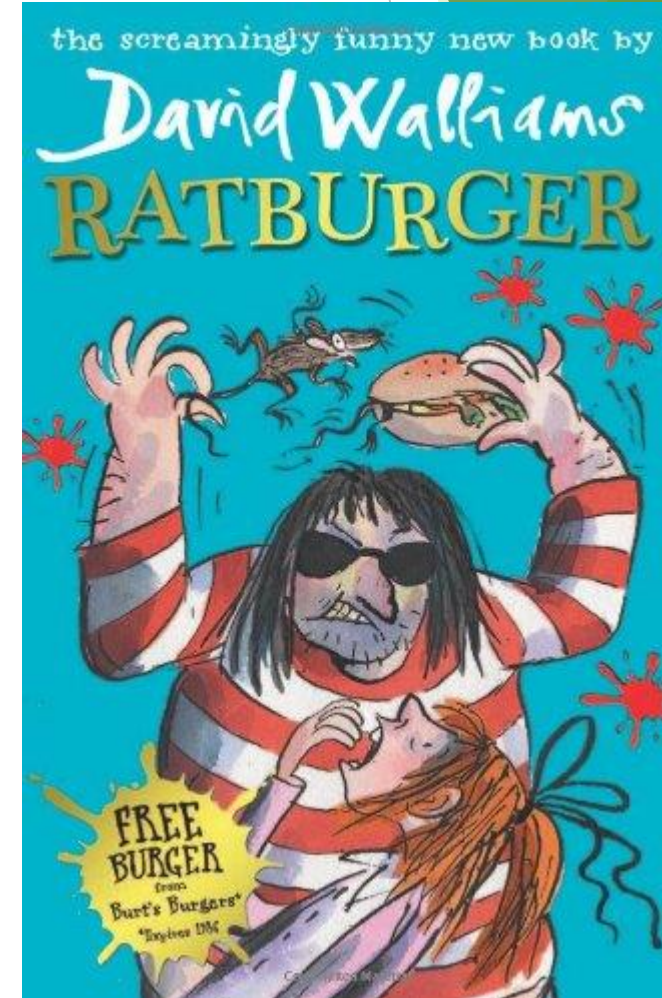
Let's Engage!

- ▶ 'Ratburger' by David Walliams



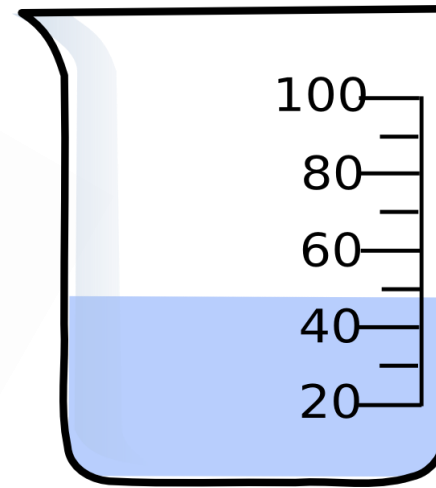
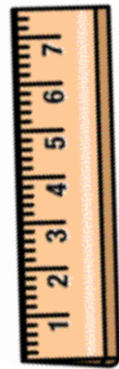
In English we will learn...

- ▶ find other interesting ways for presenting facts to an audience.



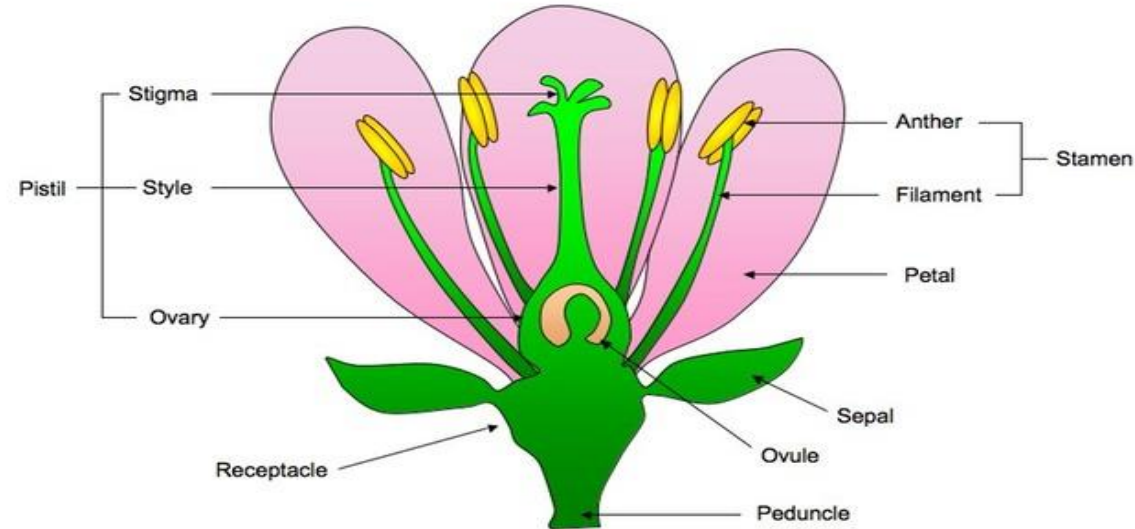
Linking Mathematics to our theme we will...
