We will be having an afternoon watching clips from the Horrible History series 'Awful Egyptians'.

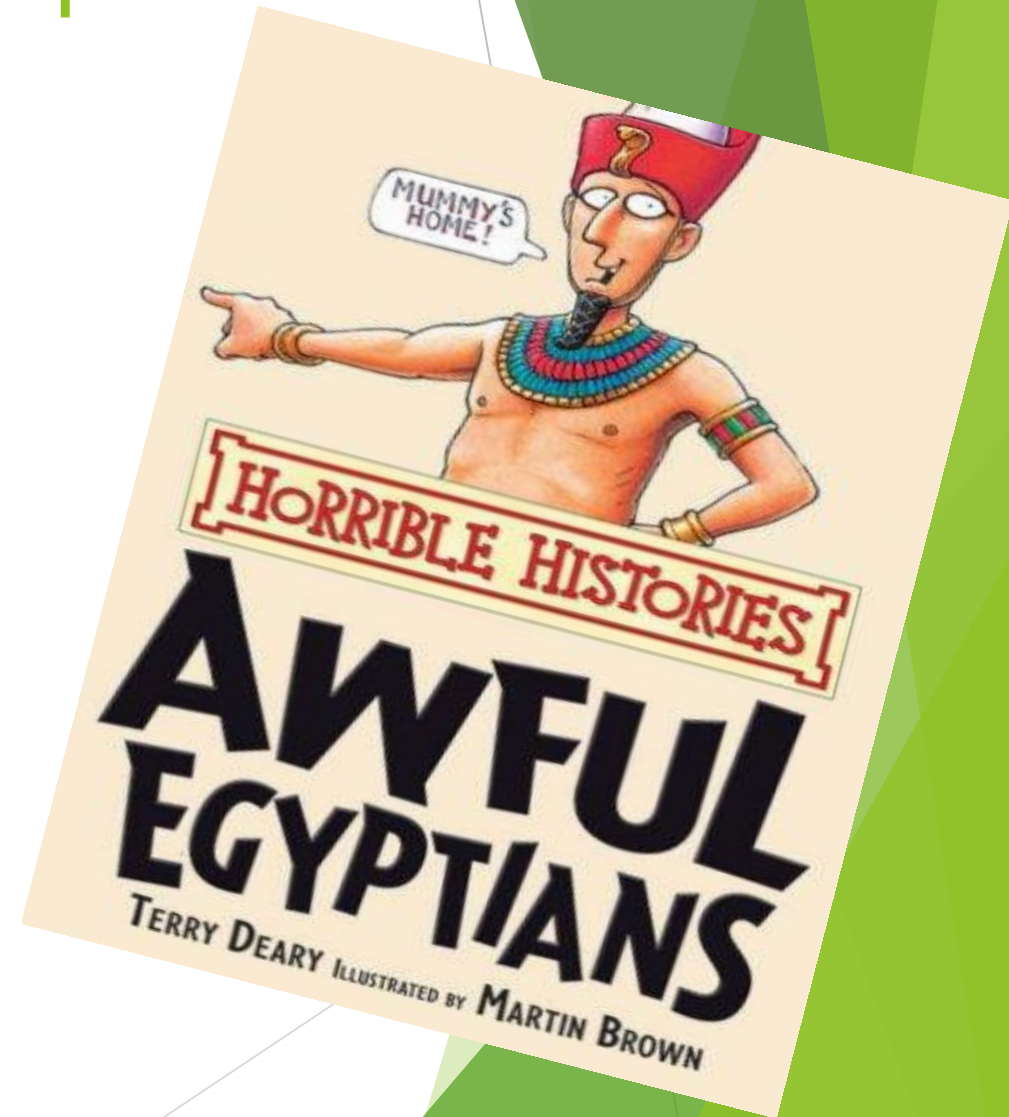
You'll be laughing your socks off at this entertaining but factual film.

- ▶ 'Awful Egyptians' by Terry Deary

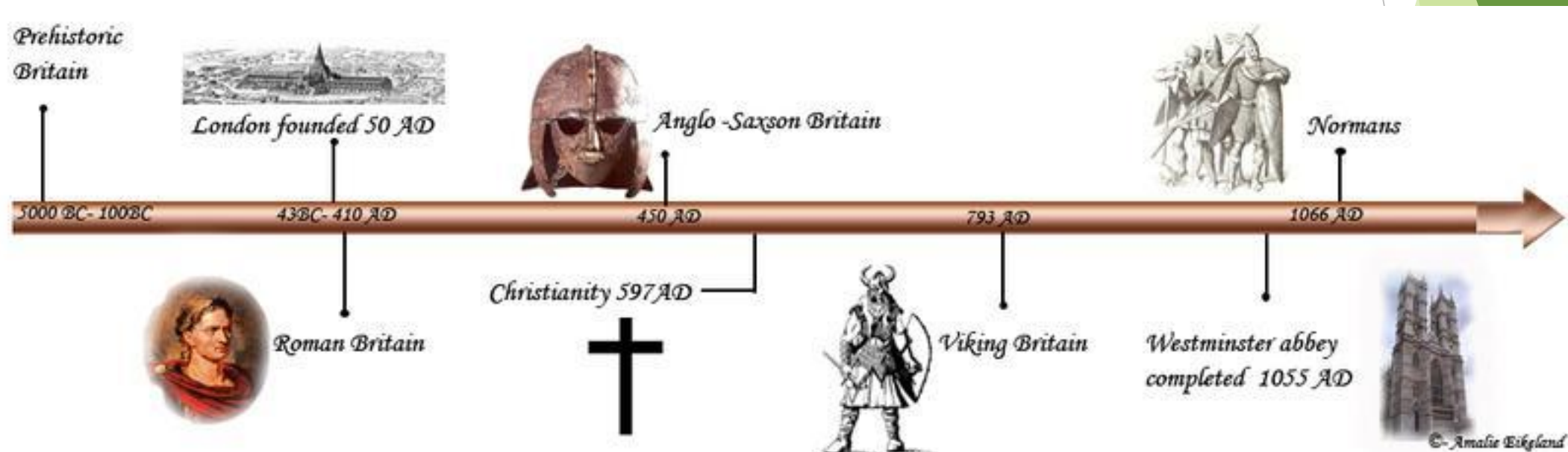


In English we will learn...

- ▶ to write and may even record documentaries about the ancient Egyptians.
- ▶ Can you write a set of instructions to tell Mrs Hall how to mummify your teacher?

Linking Mathematics to our theme we will...

- ▶ be calculating out how many years ago significant events happened and for how long pharaohs ruled for.



In Science we will learn ...

- ▶ To compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties, including their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity (electrical and thermal), and response to magnets.
- ▶ That some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution, and describe how to recover a substance from a solution.
- ▶ Use our knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating
- ▶ To give reasons, based on evidence from comparative and fair tests, for the particular uses of everyday materials, including metals, wood and plastic.
- ▶ To demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible changes
- ▶ To explain that some changes result in the formation of new materials, and that this kind of change is not usually reversible, including changes associated with burning and the action of acid on bicarbonate of soda.
