A few general comments were made, regarding communication, homework and clubs, which were addressed in the [school newsletter on September 22nd](#).

Two specific issues where the survey feedback has been particularly useful are:

- i) Improve how the school communicates the progress of children
- ii) Improve the timely of notice given for events.

The Senior Leadership Team are looking further into these comments and reviewing school protocols for communication.
