ICT School Acceptable Use Policy

The use of ICT (Information and Communication Technology) including the Internet, email, learning platforms and today's mobile technologies are an integral element of learning in our school.

Bradwell C E (C) Infant School has a monitoring solution where web based activity is monitored and recorded. The Schools internet access is controlled through CAPITA web filtering service.

To make this as successful and as beneficial as possible for all learners, we expect all pupils to act safely and responsibly when using technology both within, and outside of, the school environment.

This is particularly relevant when using Social Network Sites that are becoming increasingly popular amongst both the adult population and young people. However, many sites do have age-restriction policies where the minimum acceptable age is 13 years. Any child who sets up or uses such a site and is below the acceptable age is in clear breach of these age-restriction policies and therefore we actively discourage this in our school.

The enclosed ICT Acceptable Use Policy forms part of the wider School eSafety Policy and alongside the school's Behaviour Policy & Anti-Bullying Policy outlines those principles we expect our pupils to uphold for the benefit of both themselves and the wider school community. (All policies can be found on the school website or a hard copy is available from the school office)

Your support in achieving these aims is essential and I would therefore ask that you please read and discuss the enclosed ICT Acceptable Use Policy with your child and return the completed document as soon as possible.

Signing the School Acceptable Use Policy helps us to maintain responsible use of ICT and safeguards the pupils in school.
